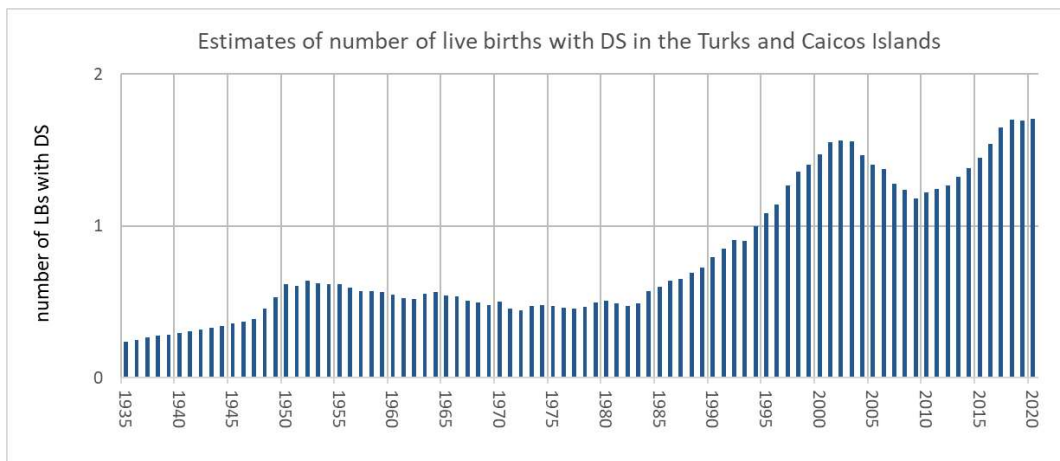
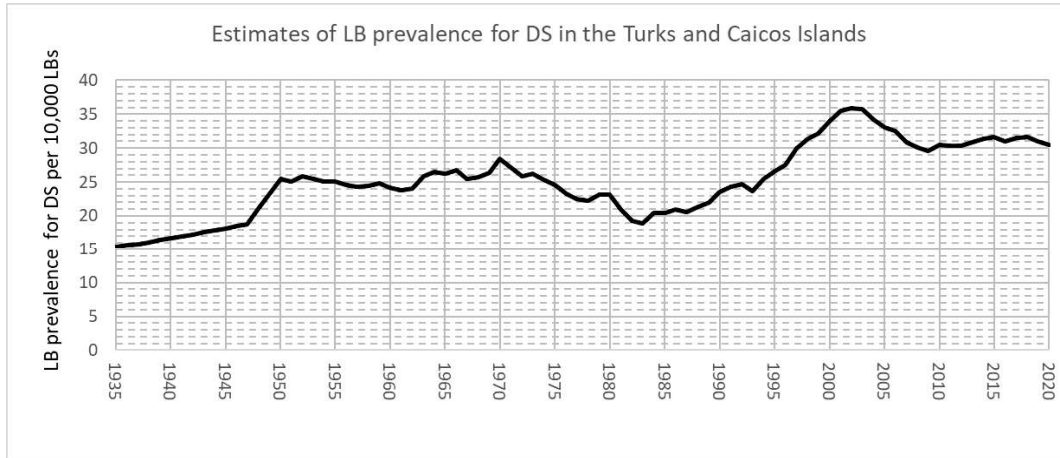


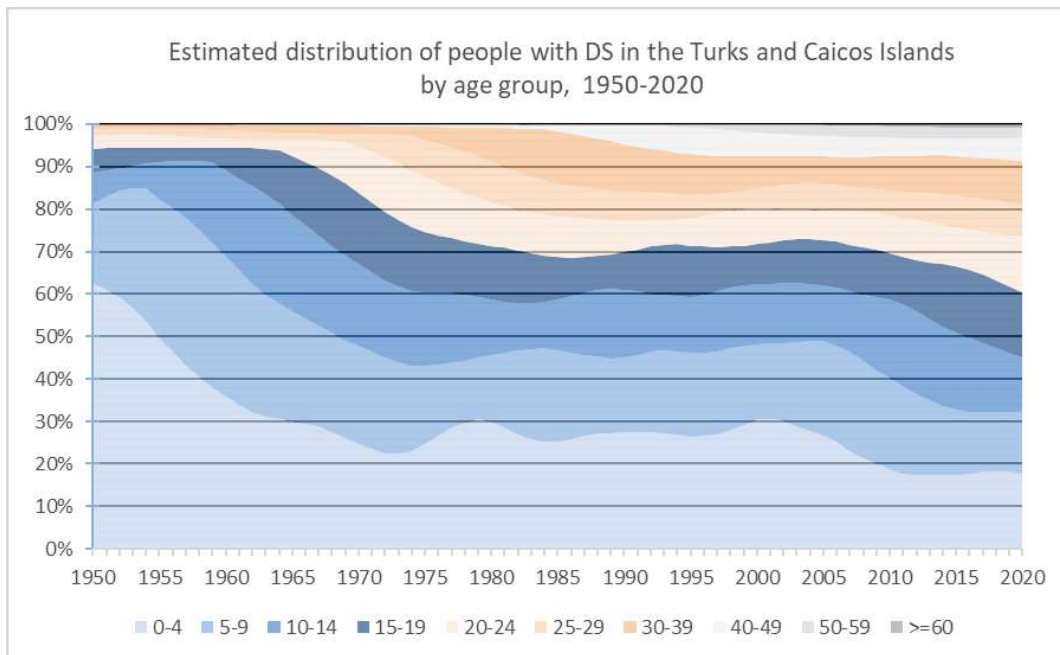
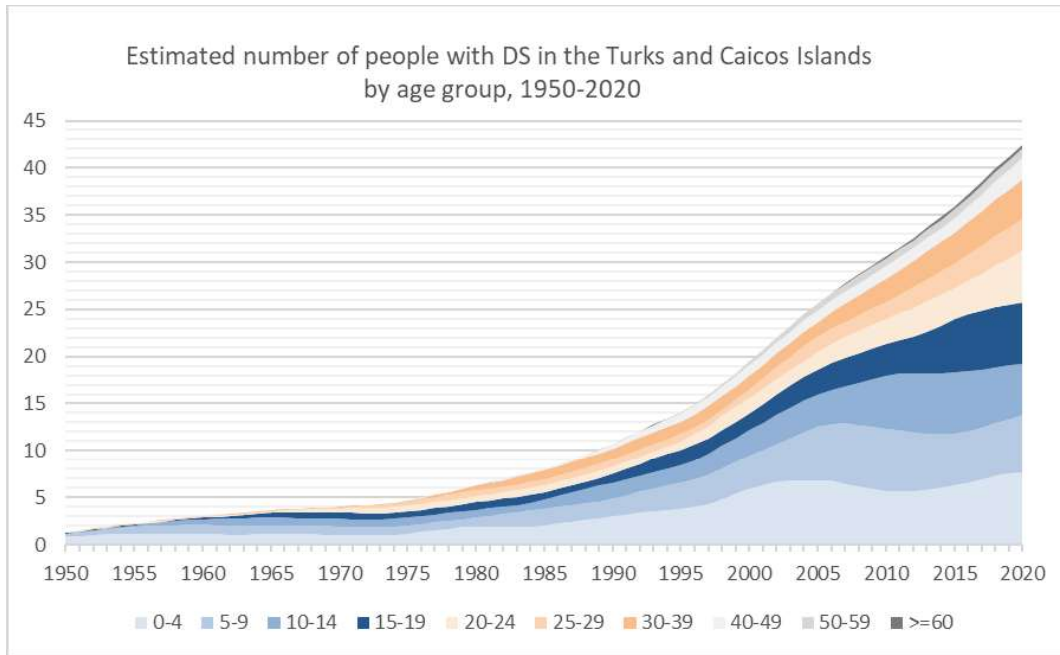


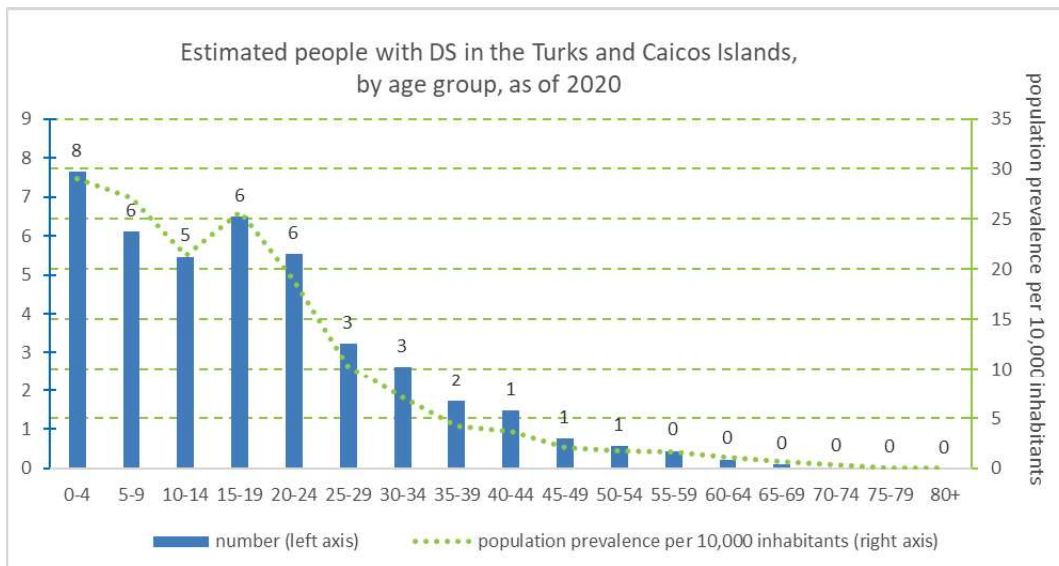
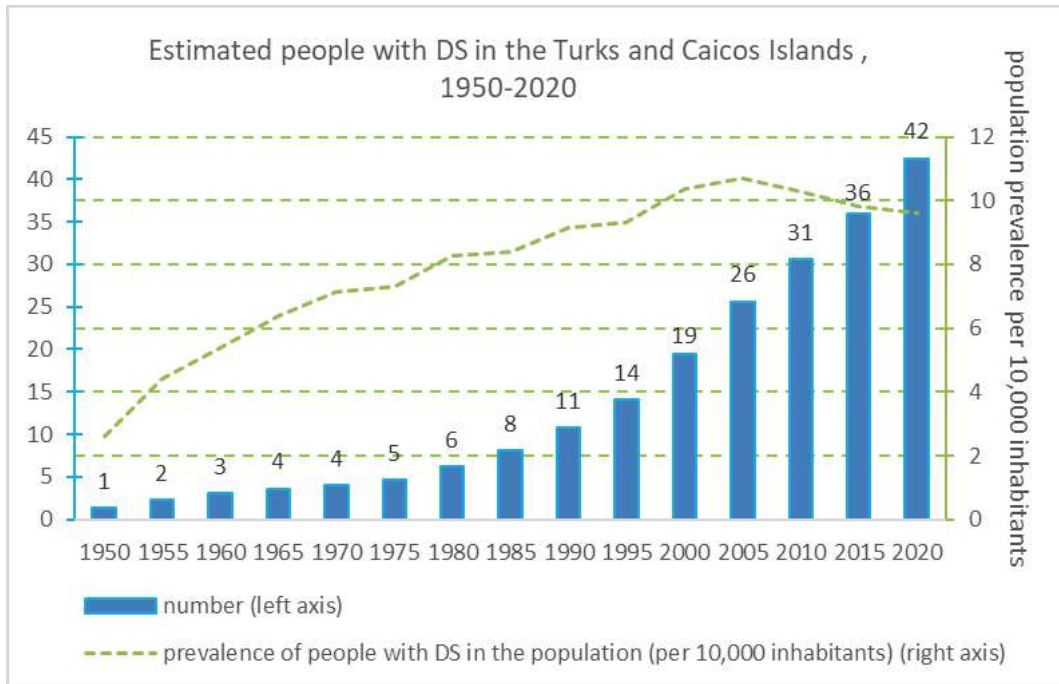


Turks and Caicos Islands

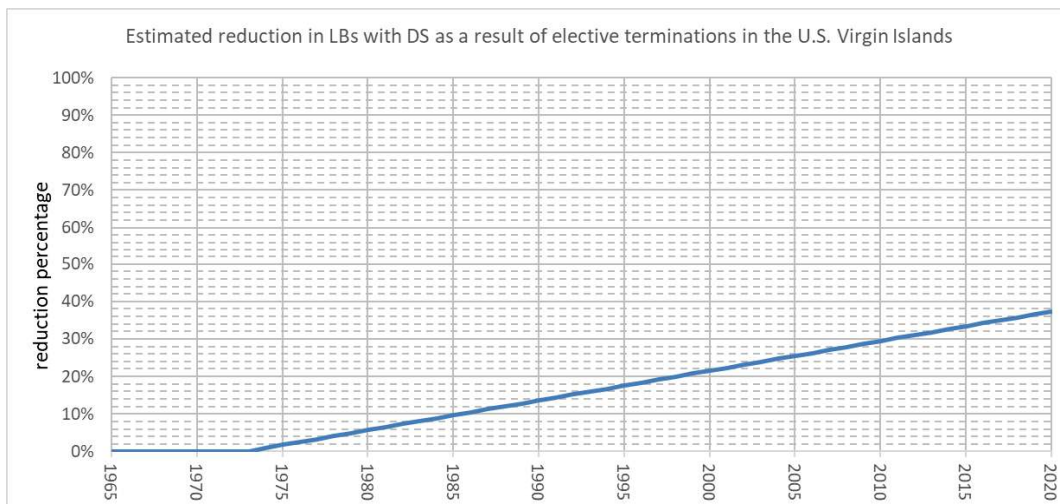
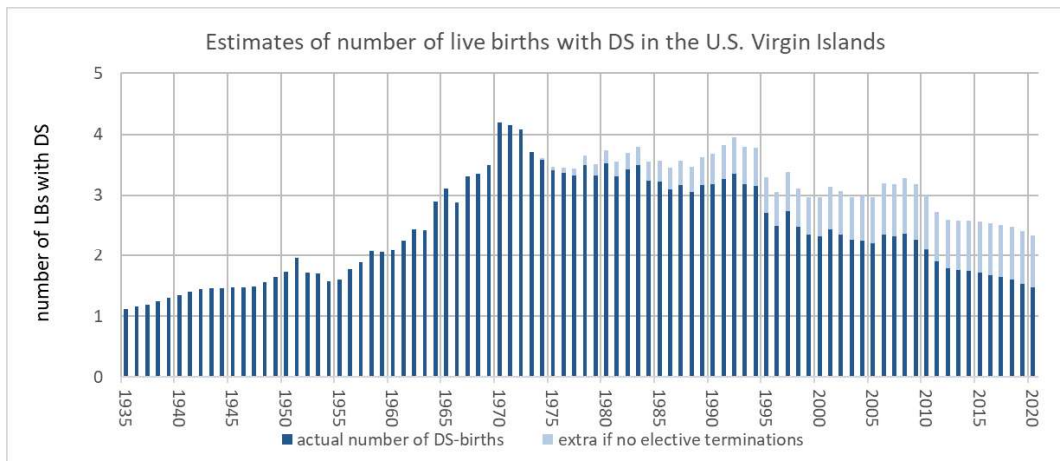
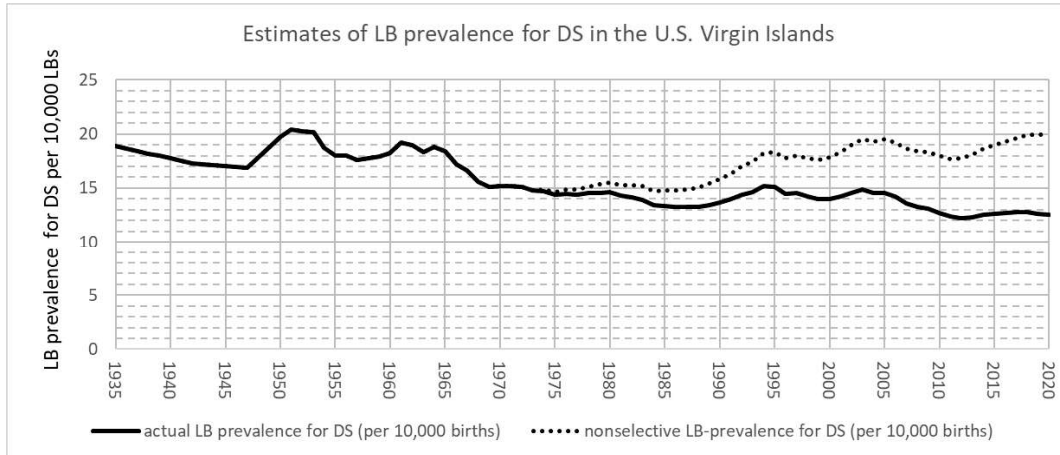


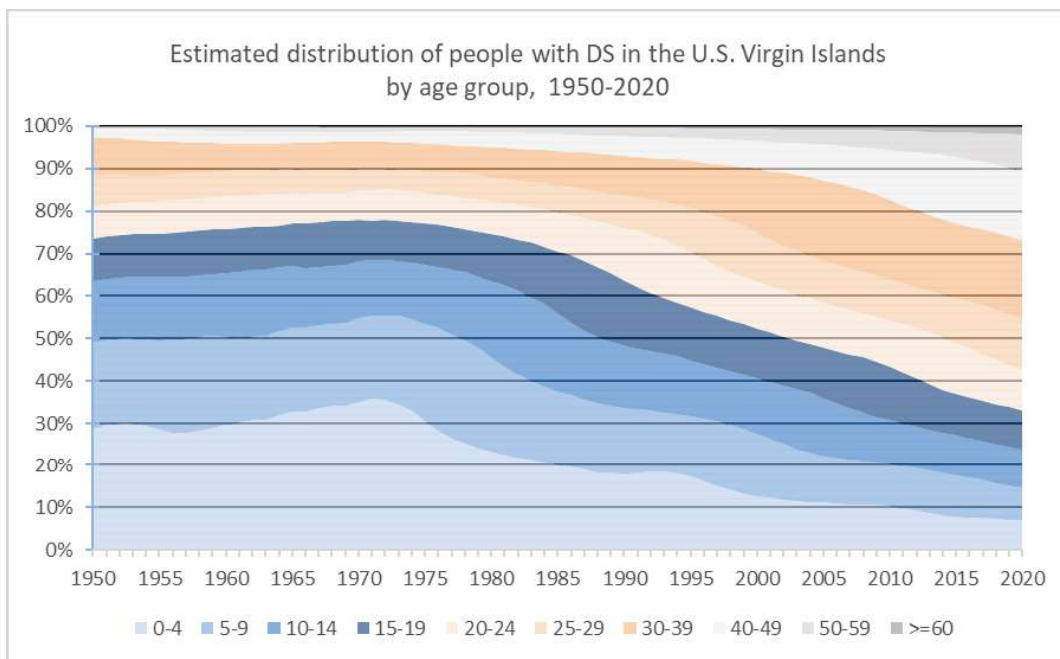
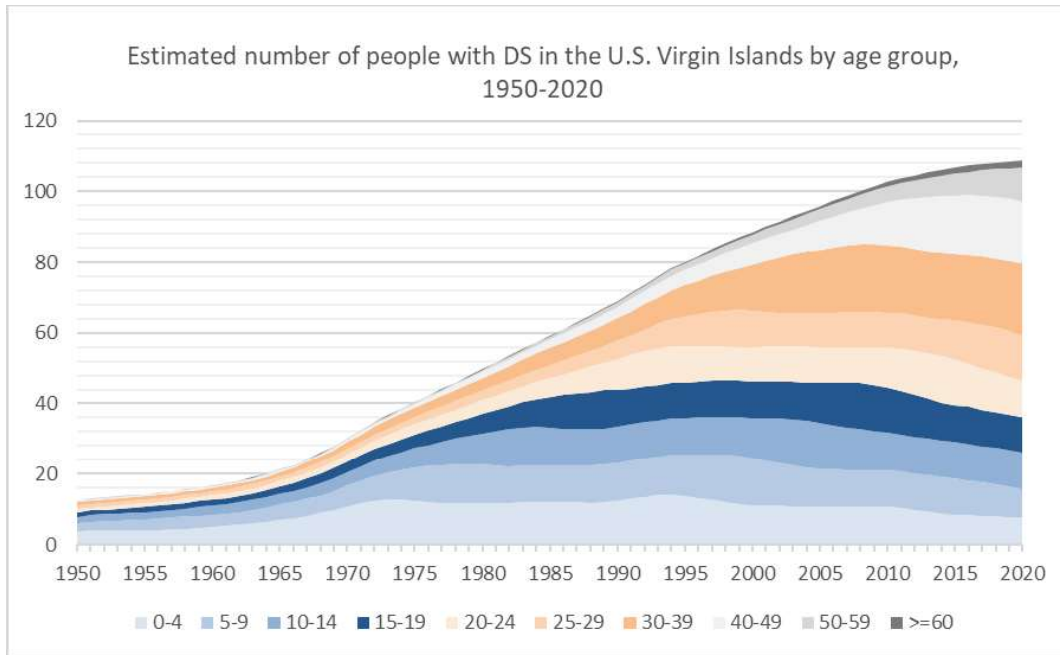


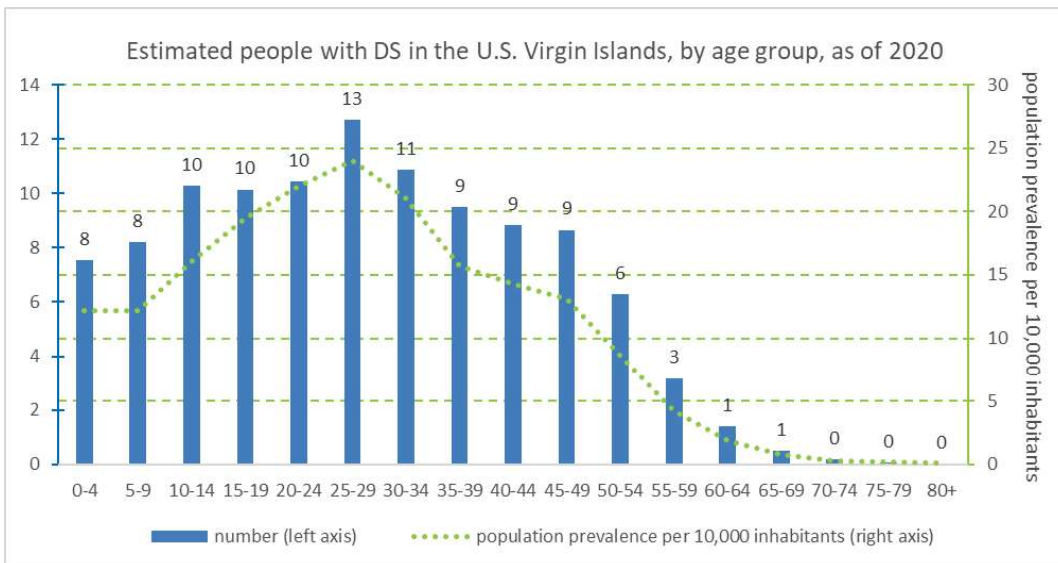
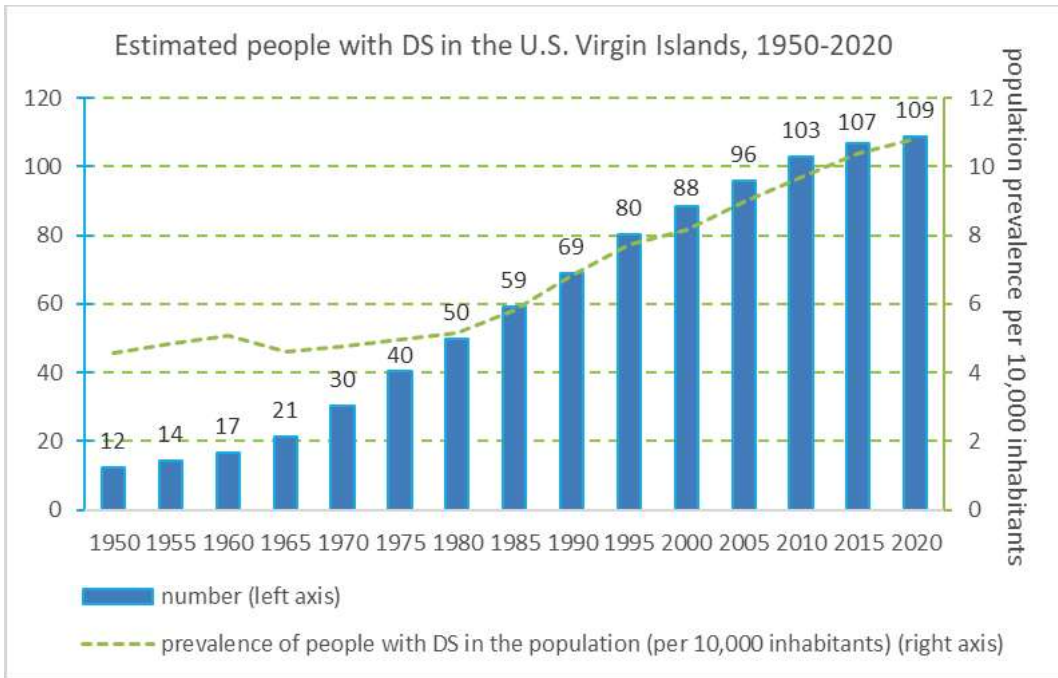


United States Virgin Islands

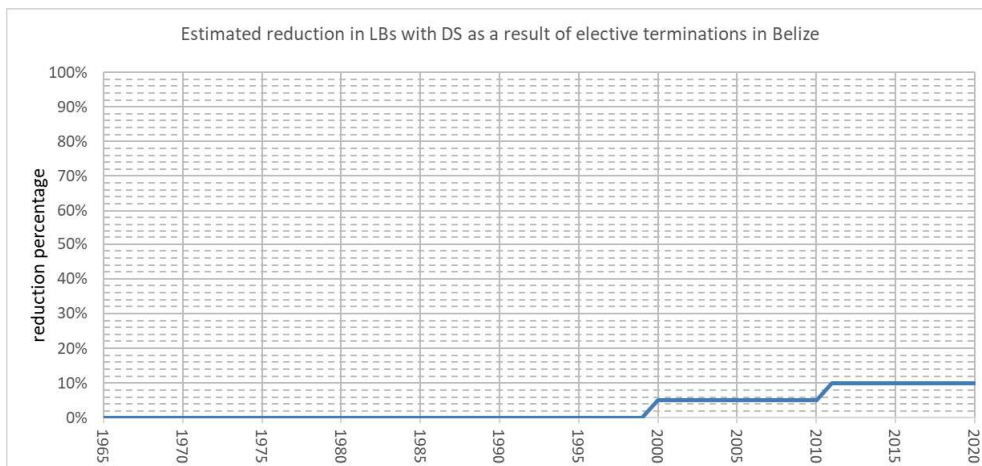
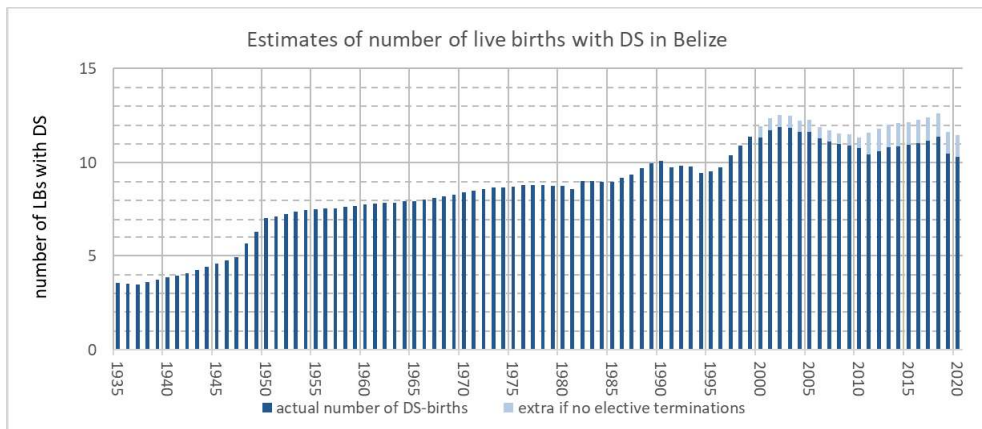
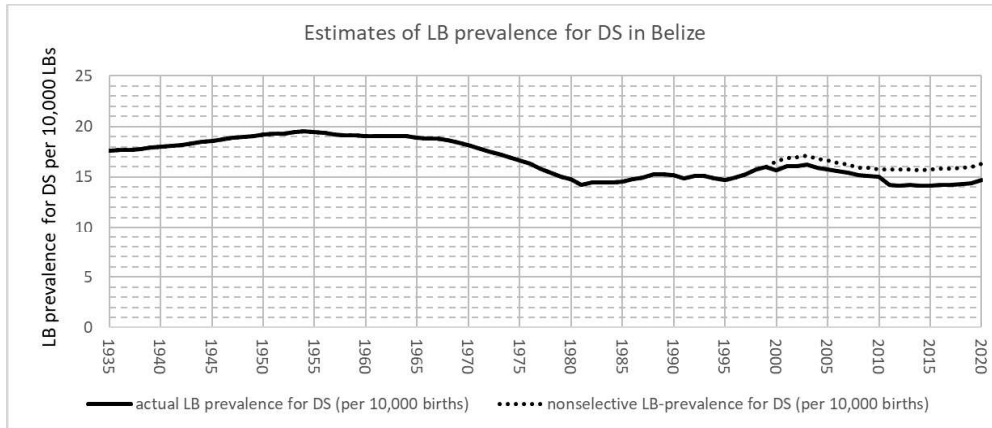


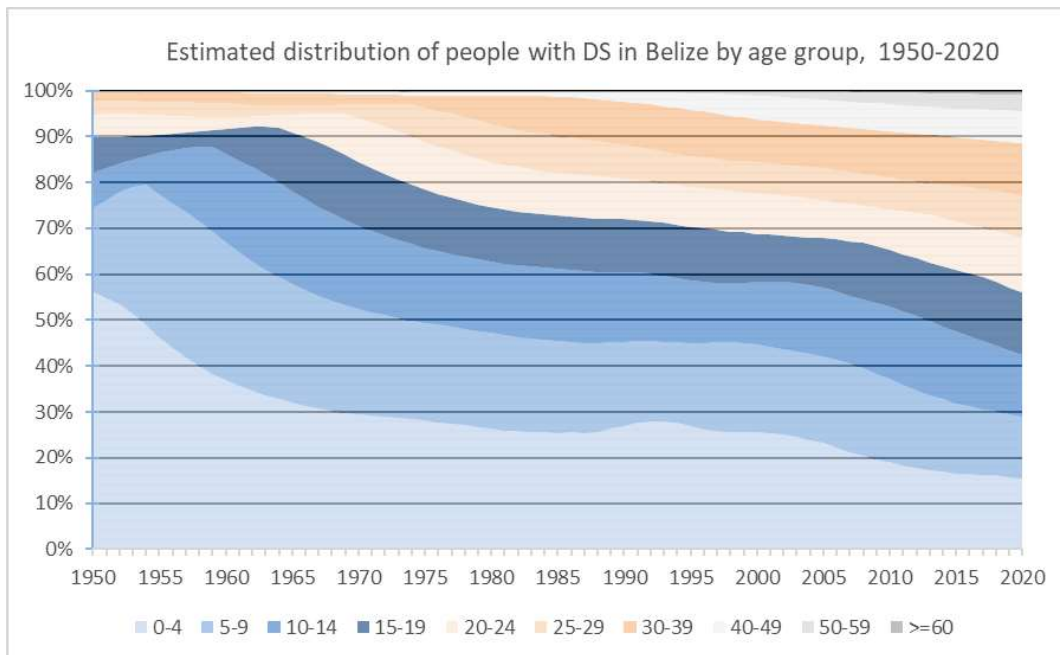
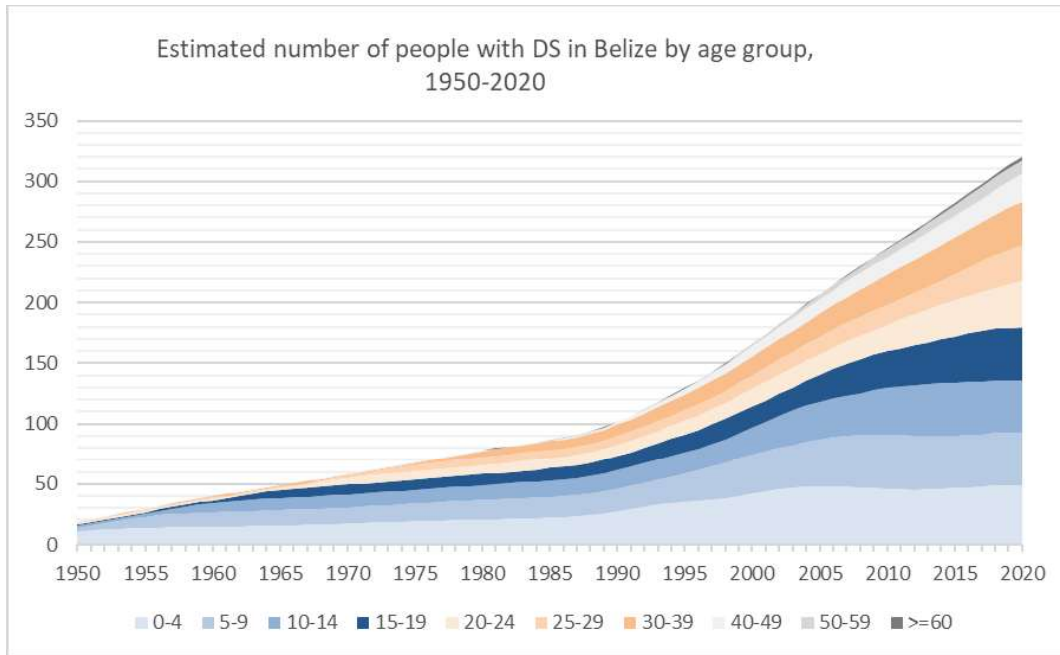


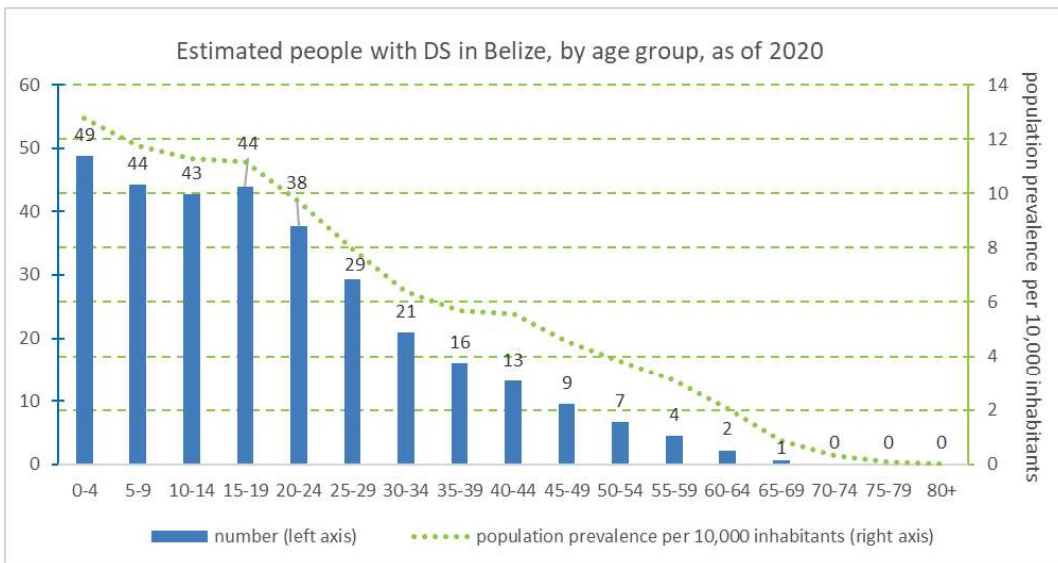
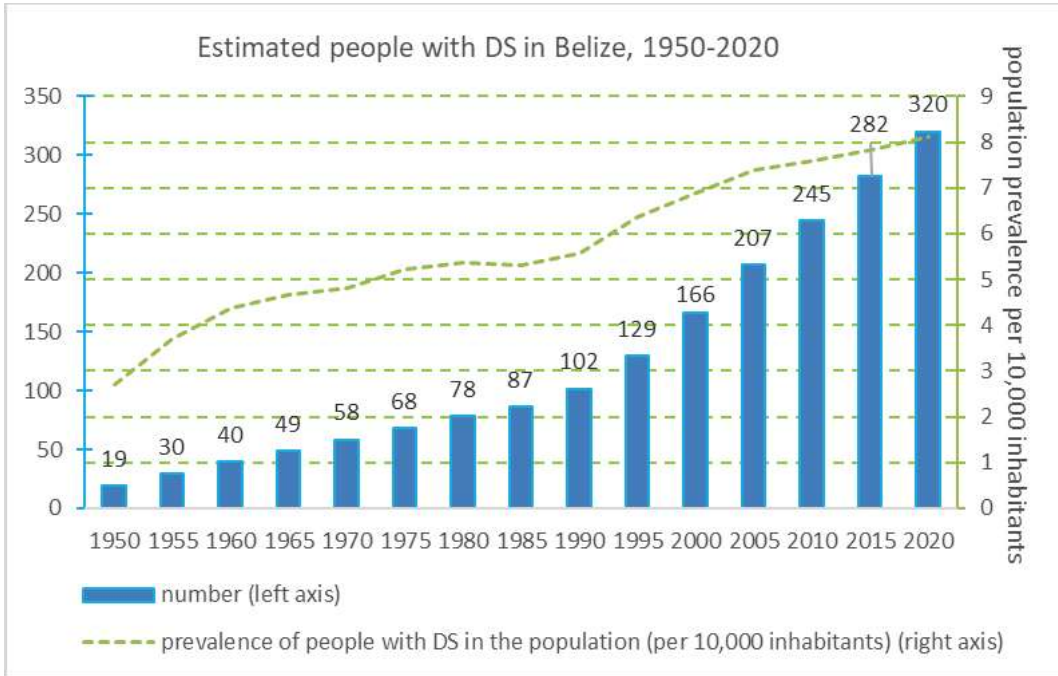
Countries in Central America (and Mexico)

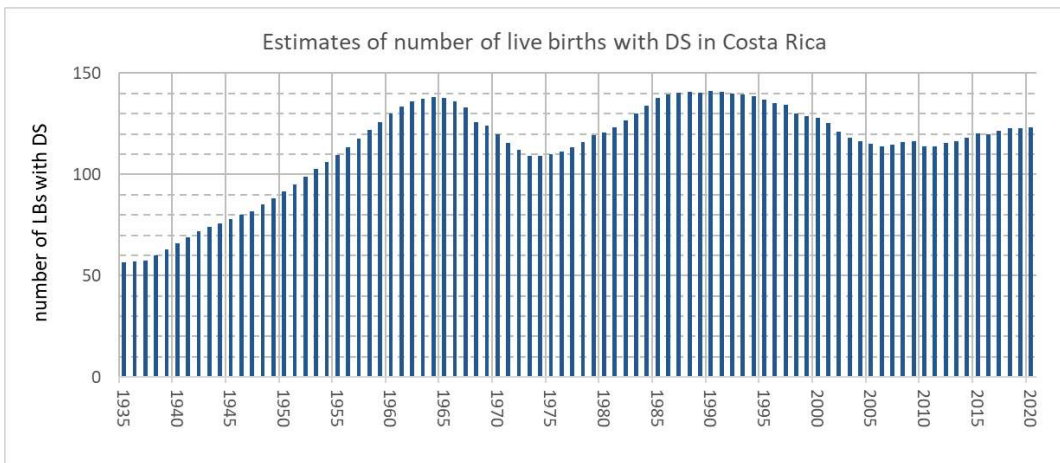
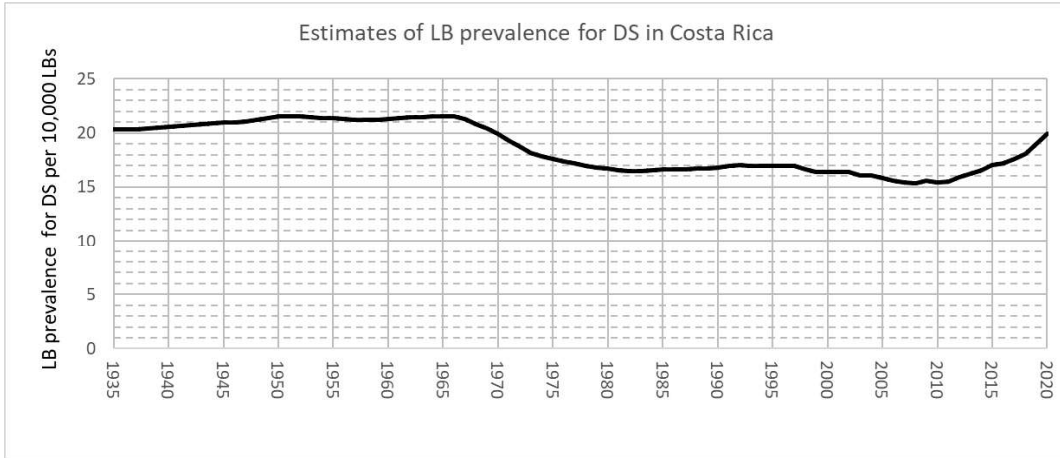


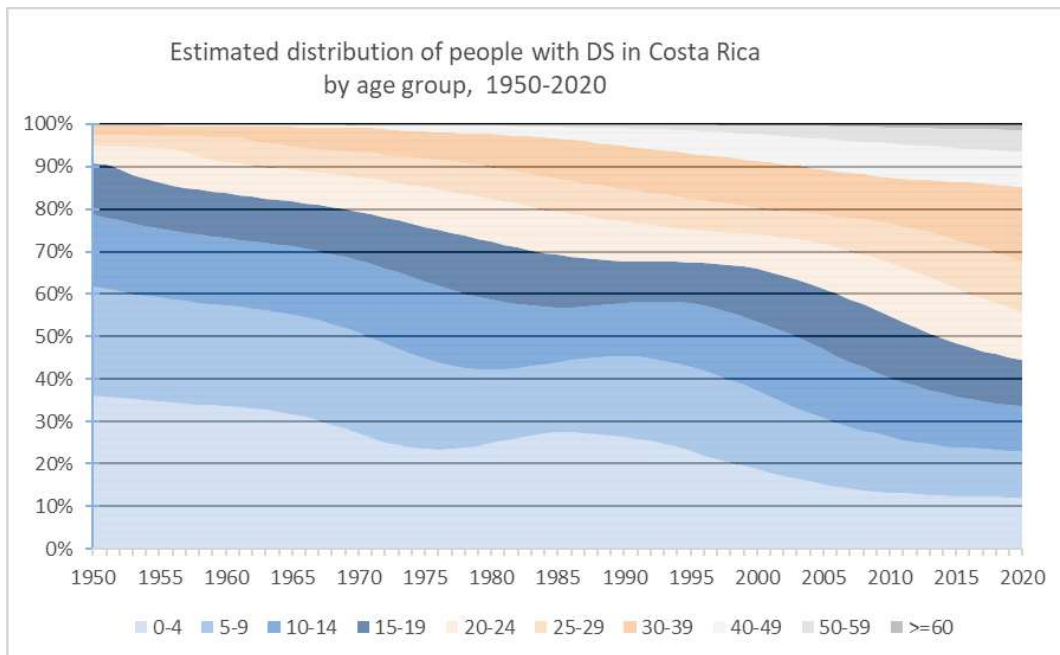
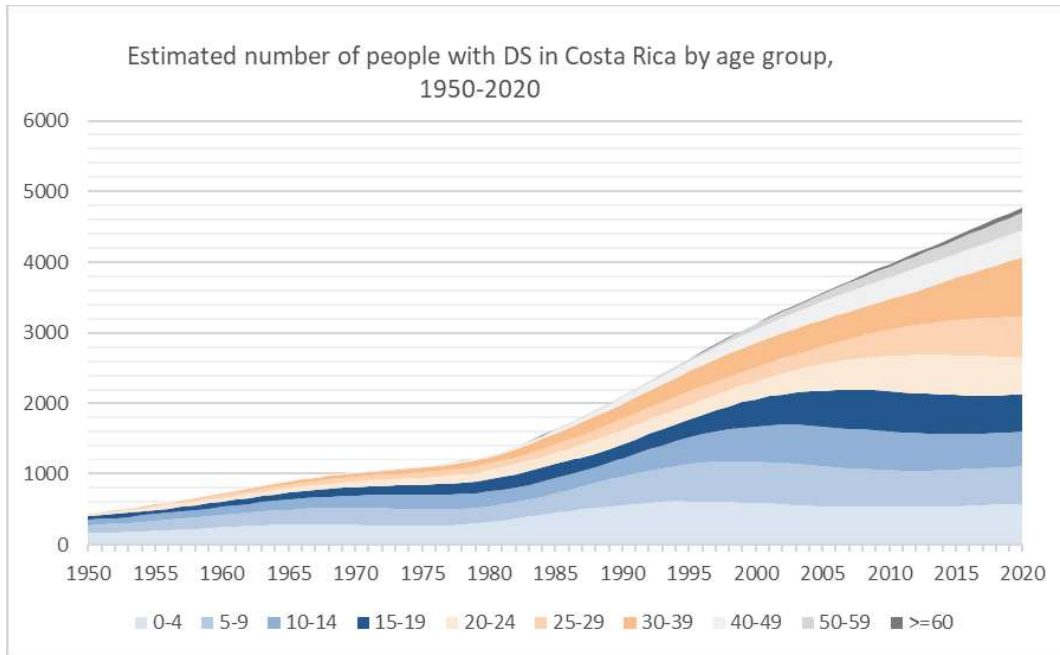


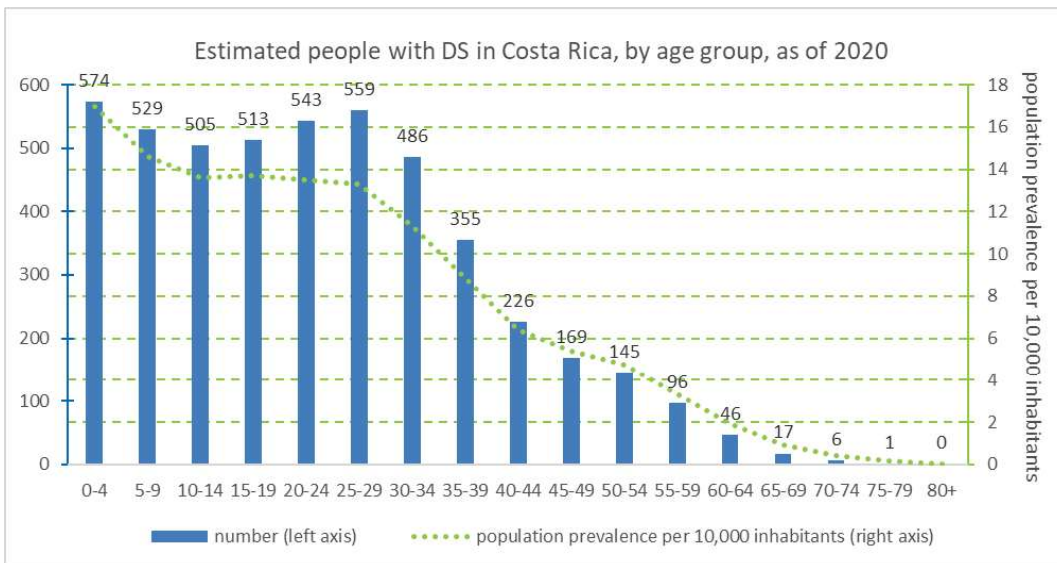
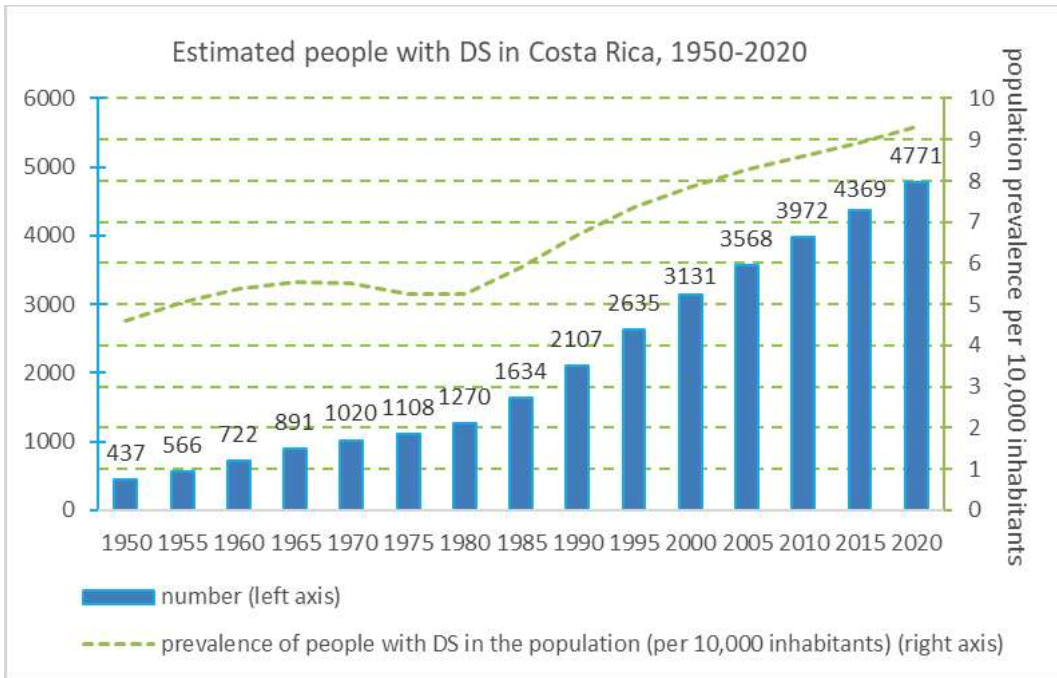


Costa Rica

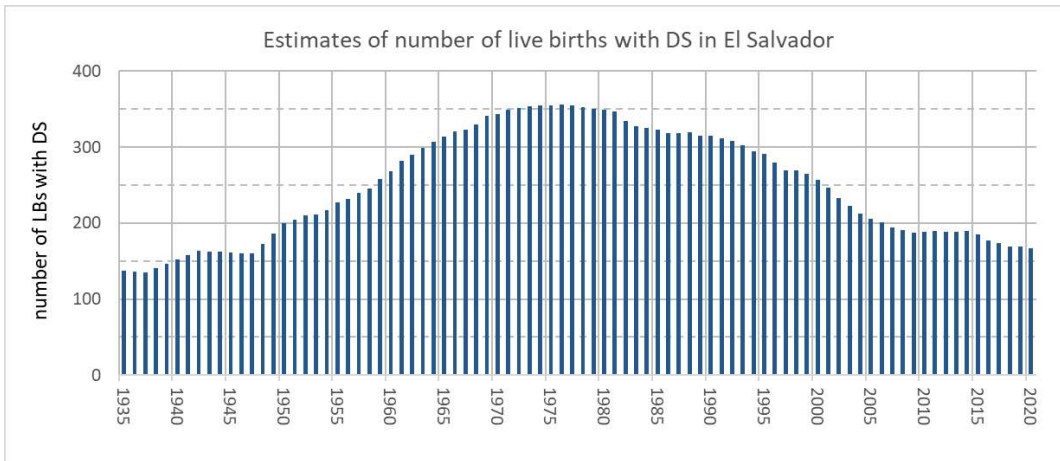
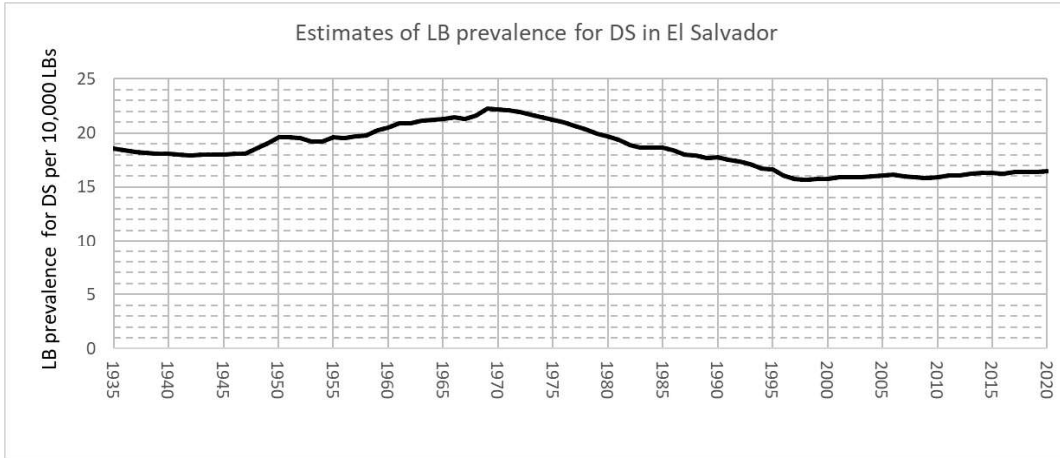


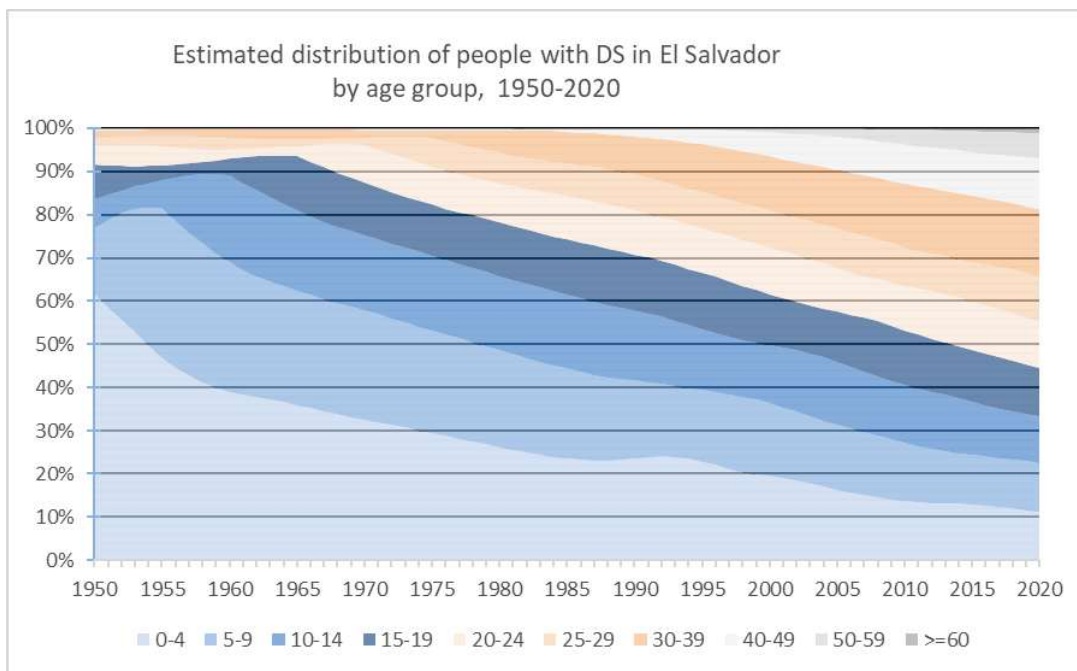
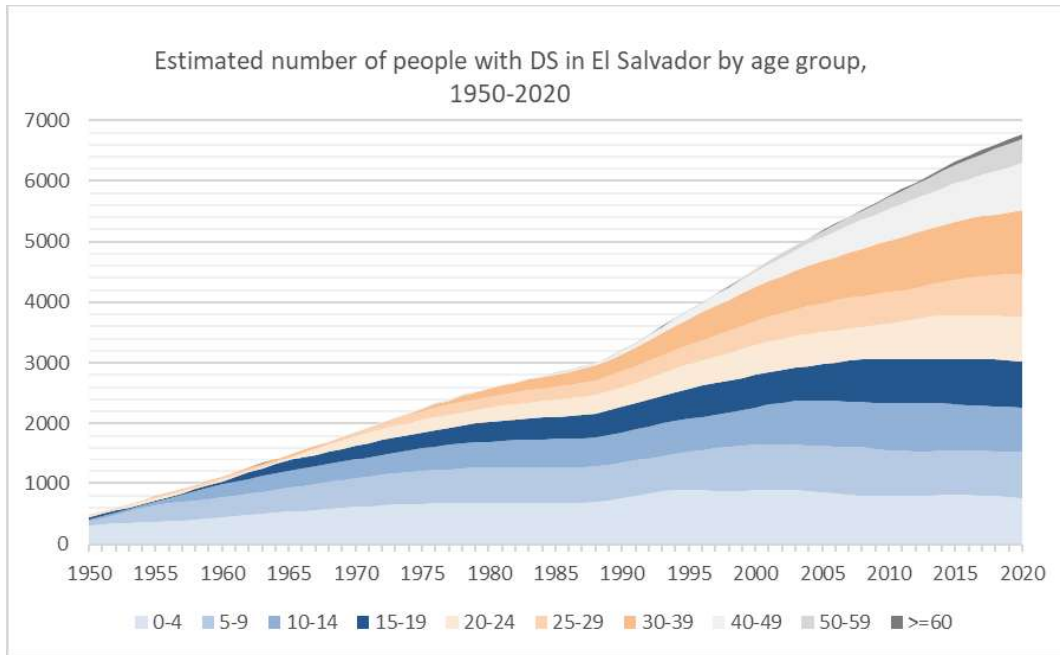


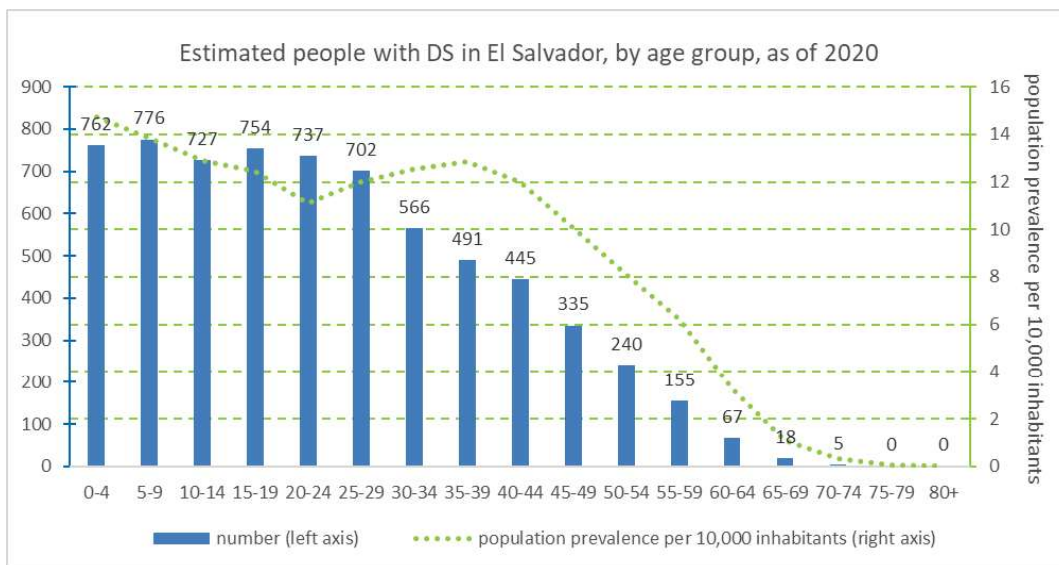
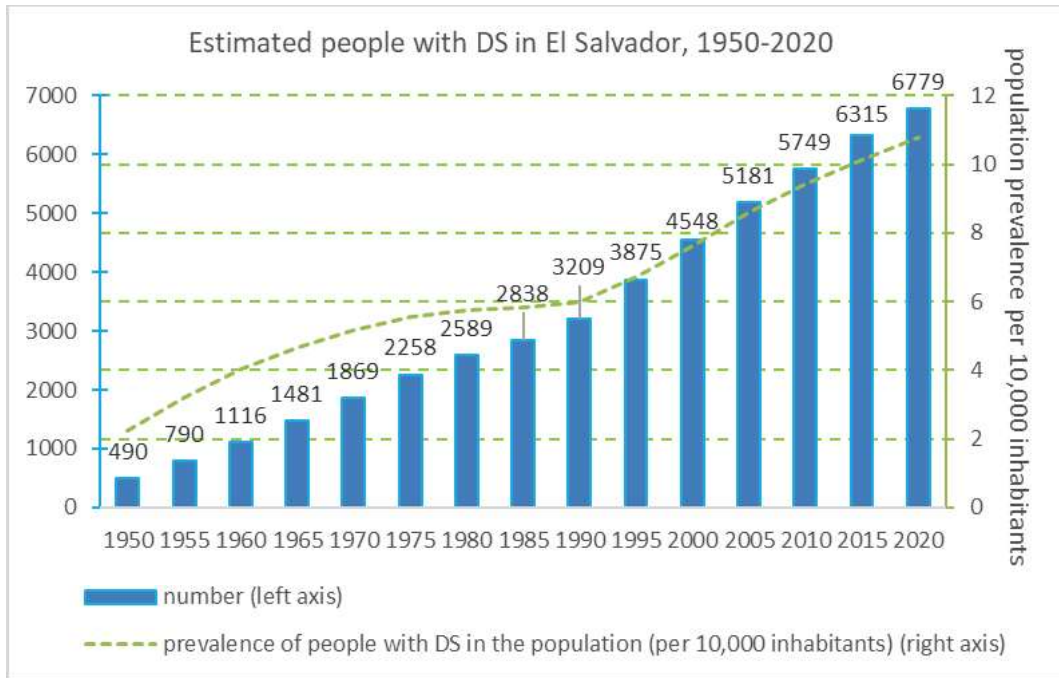


El Salvador

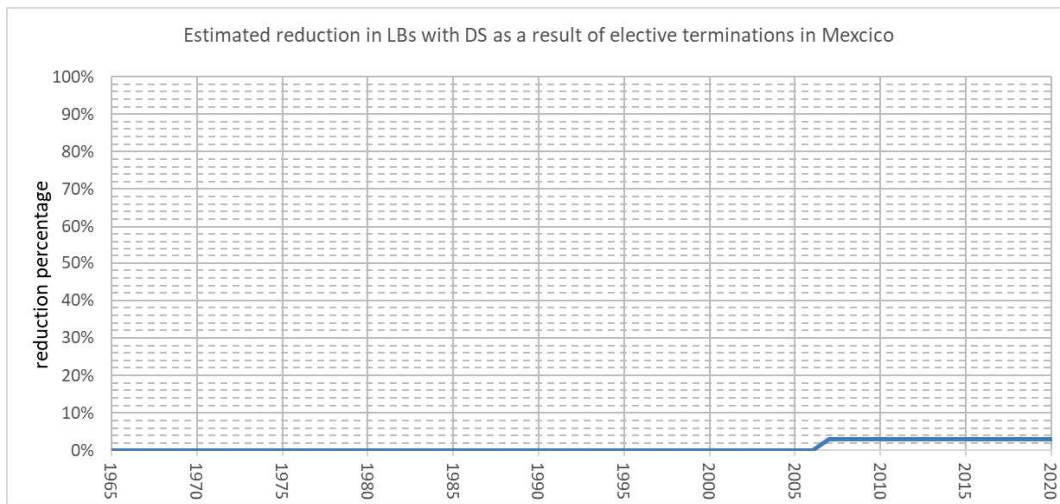
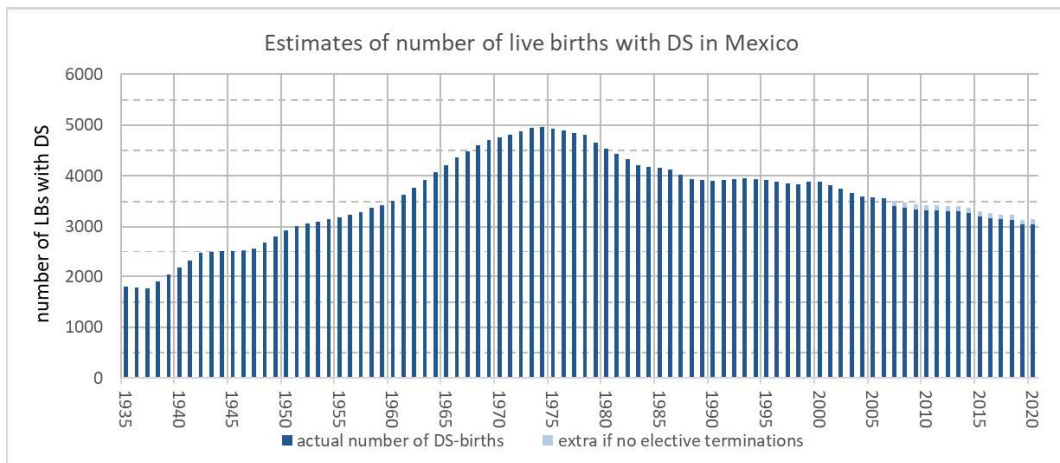
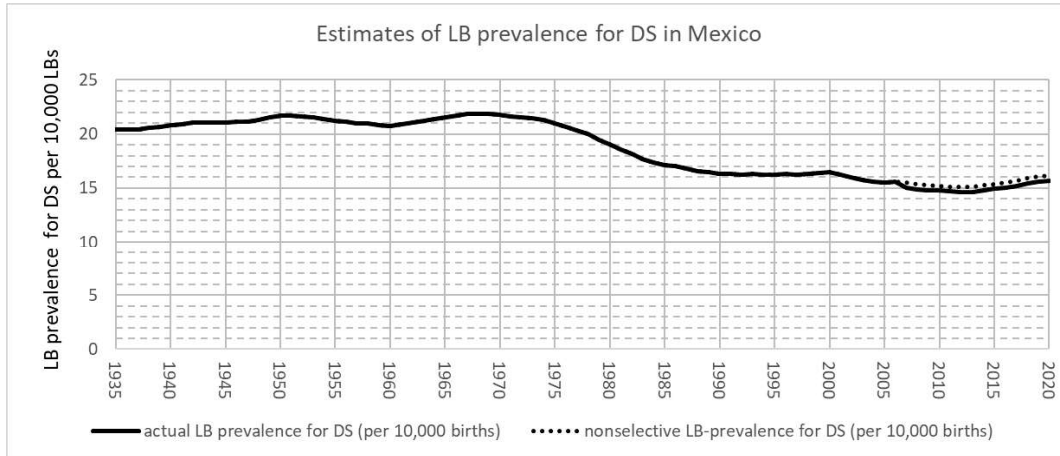


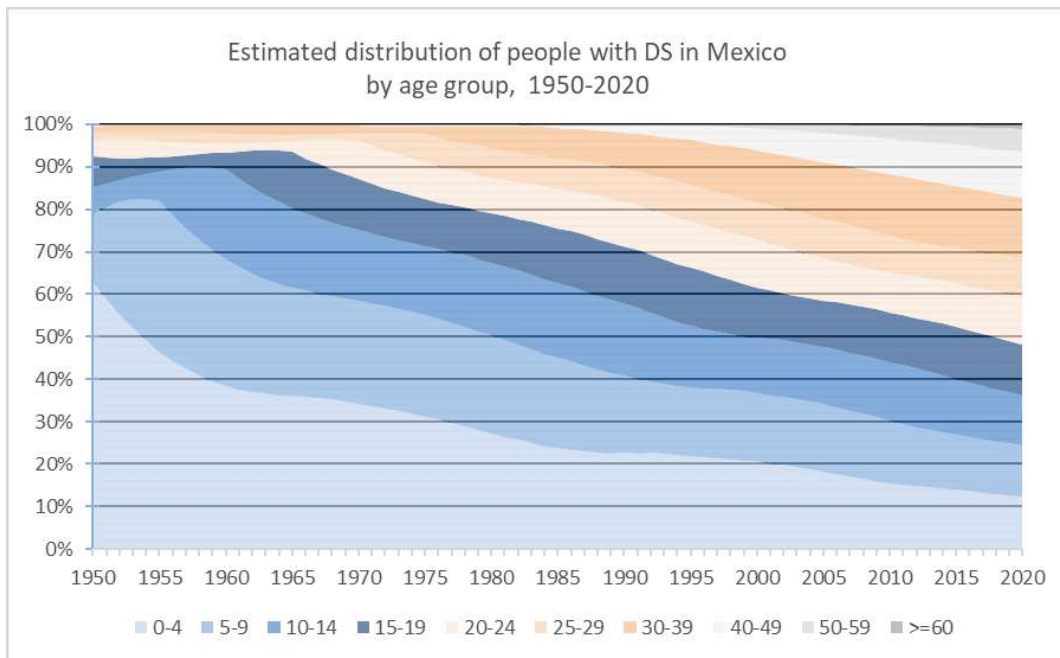
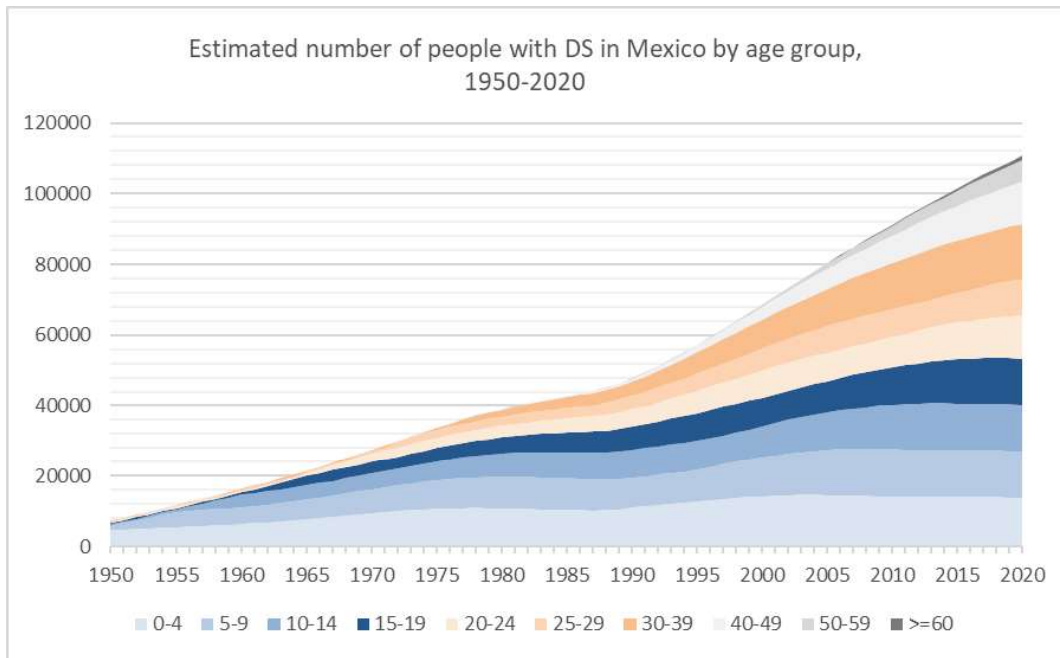


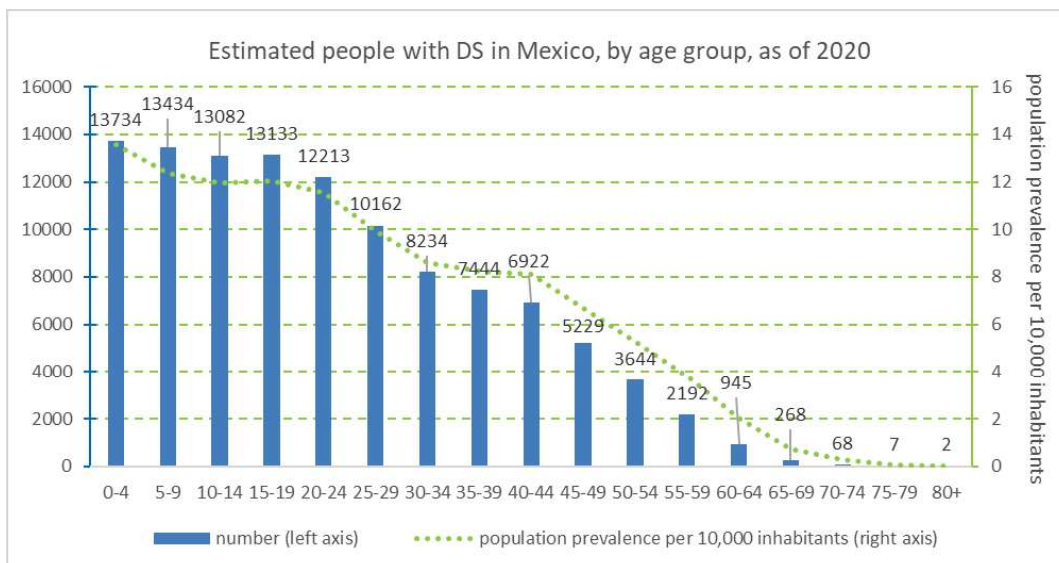
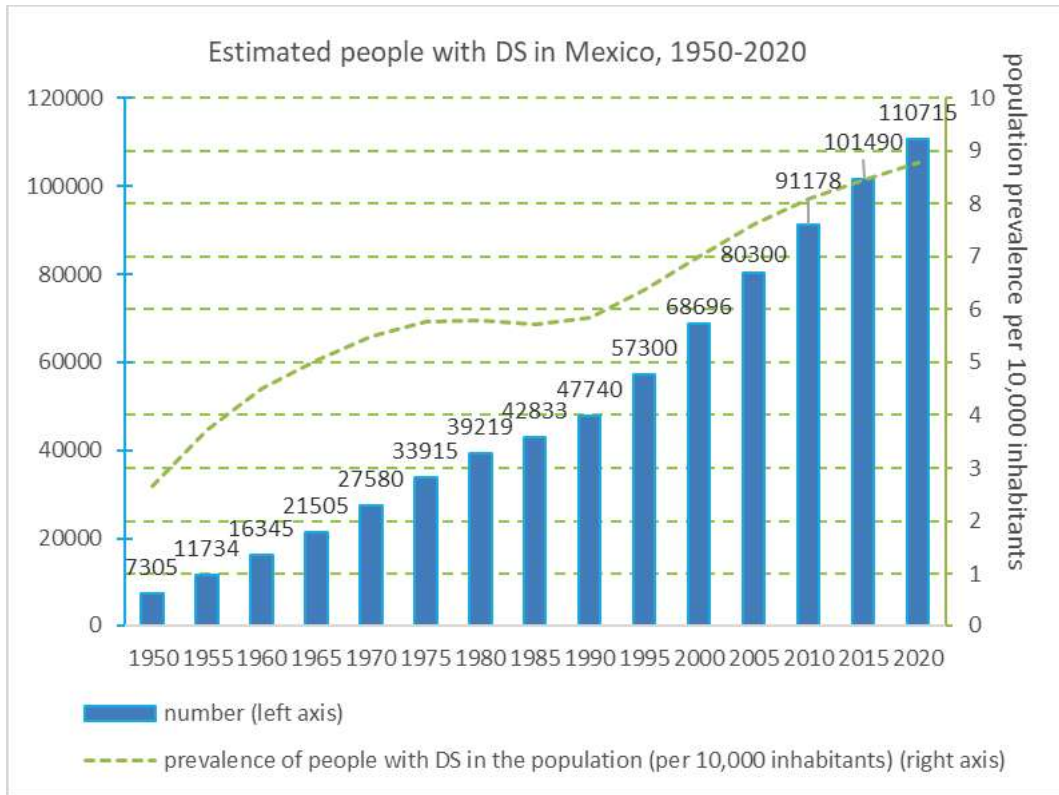


Mexico

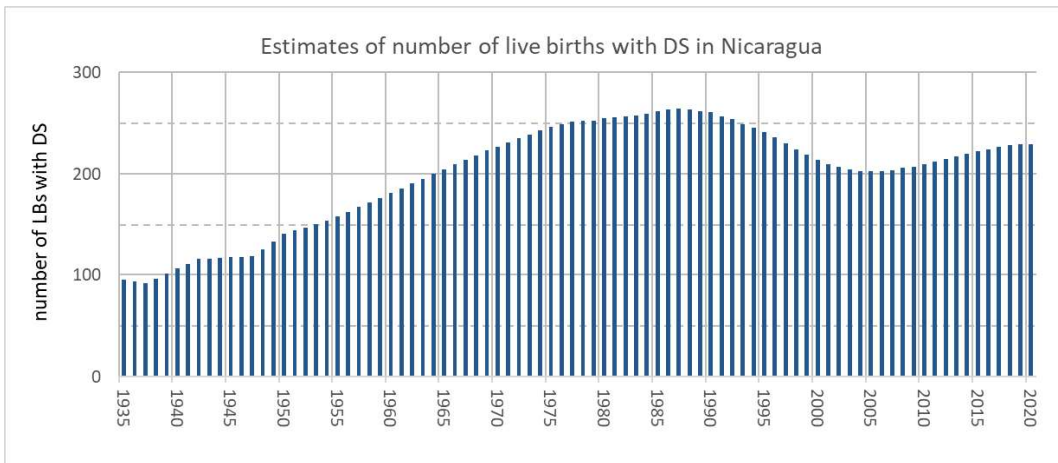
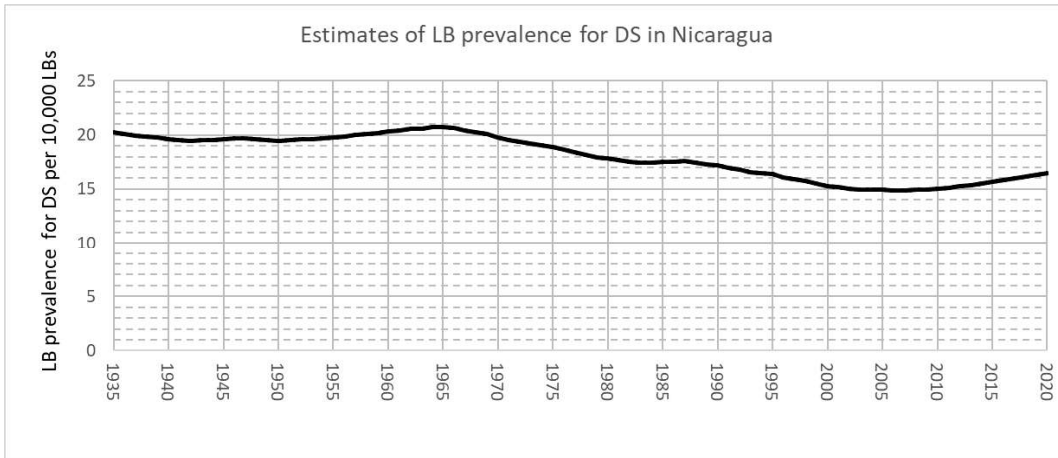


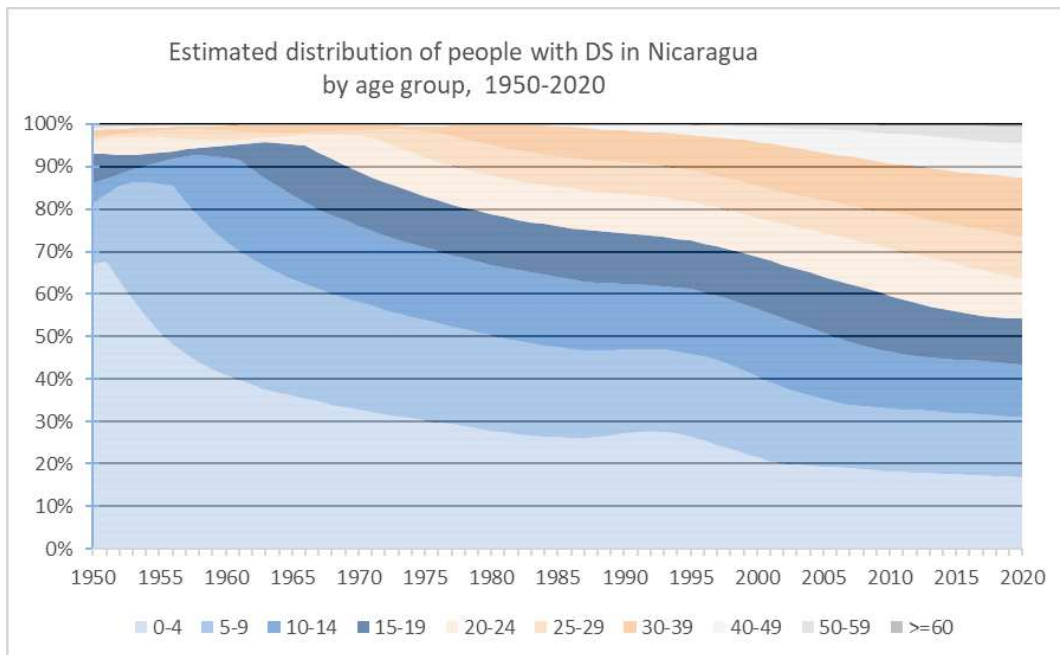
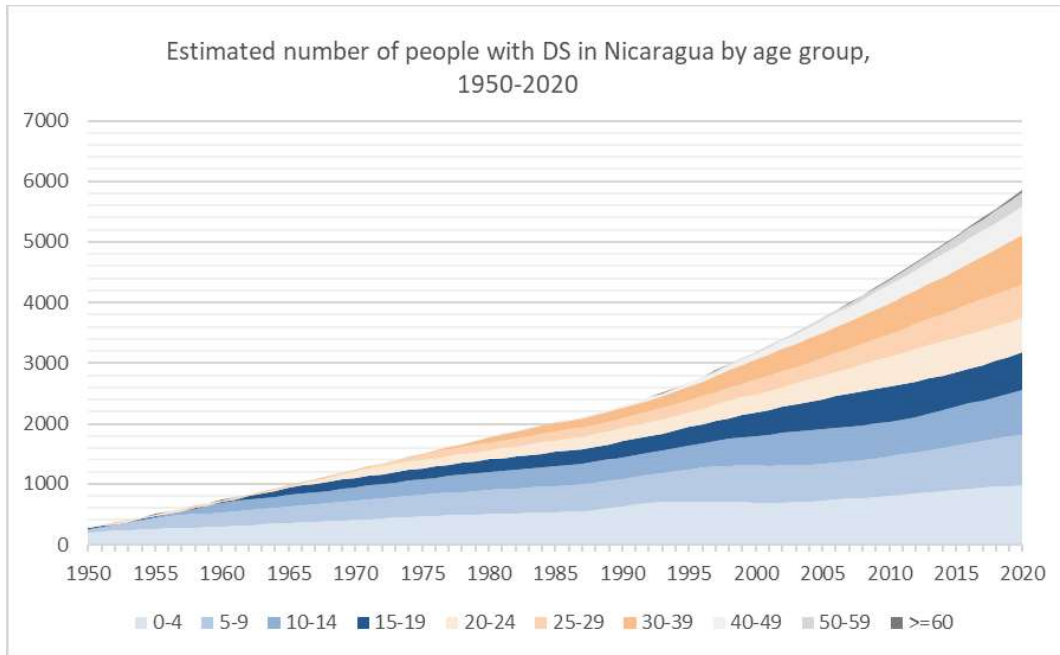


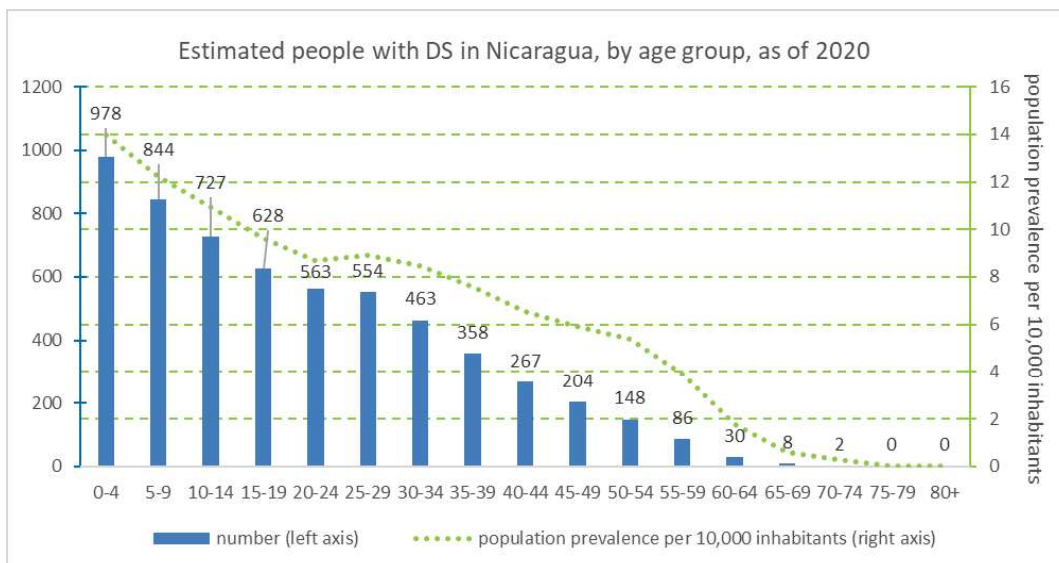
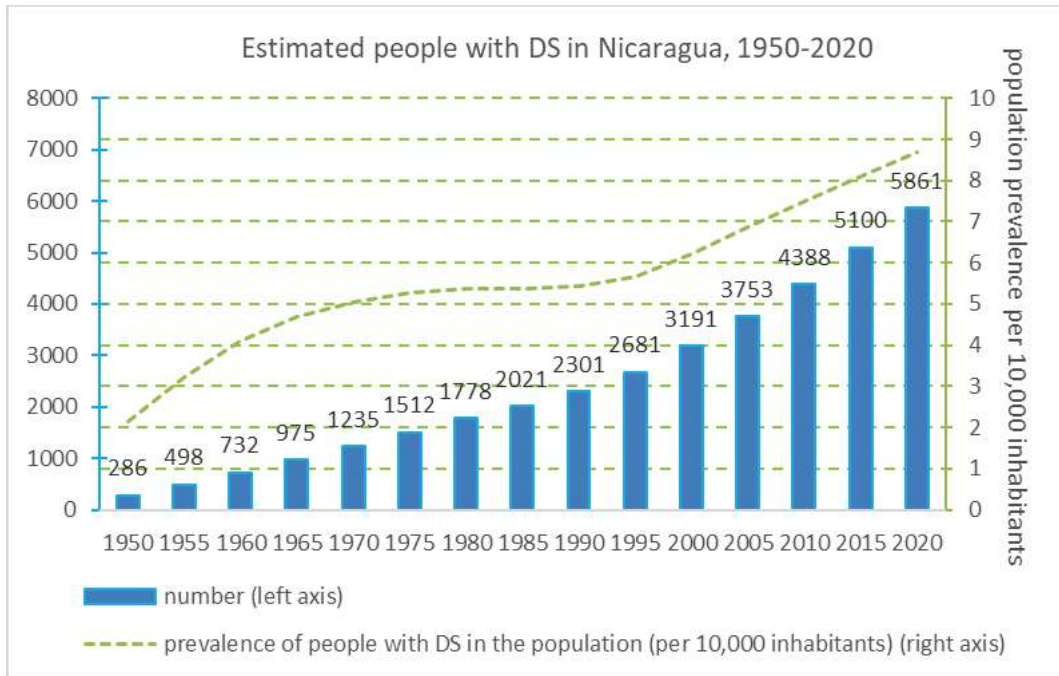


Nicaragua

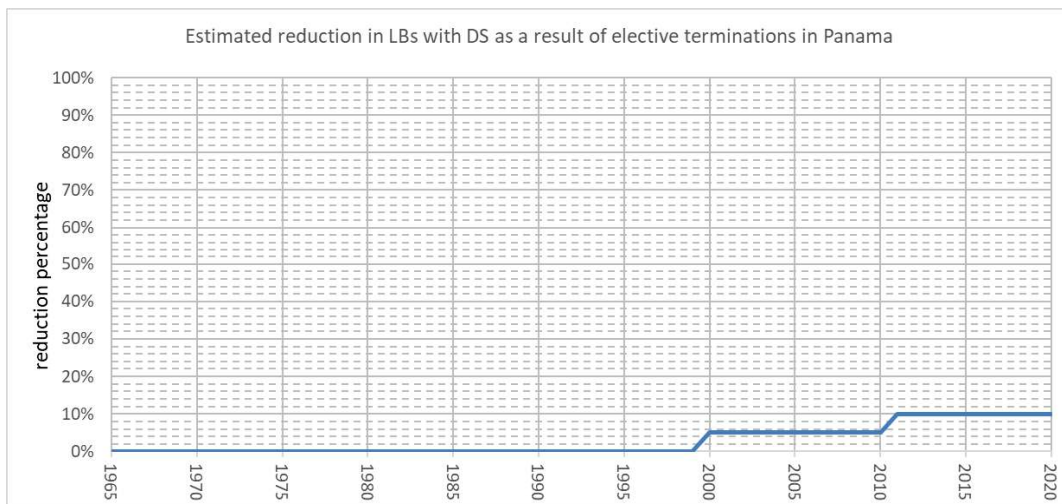
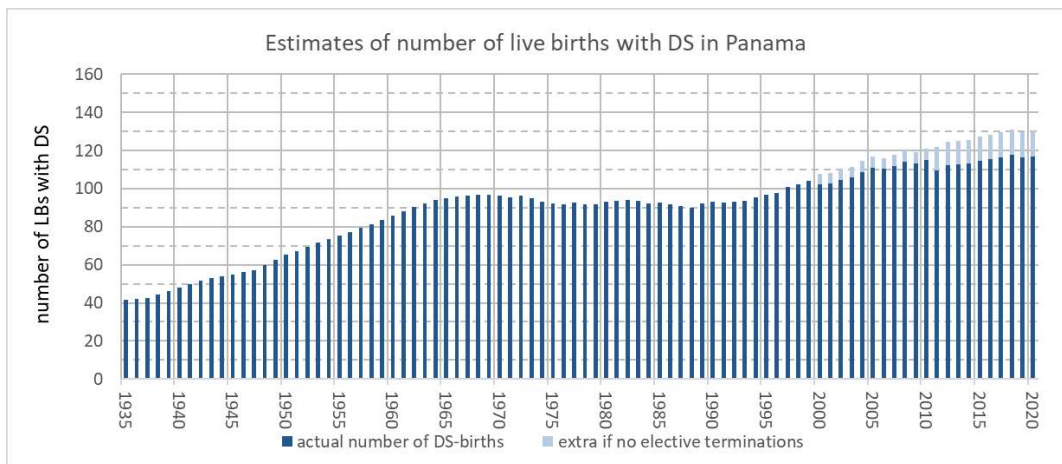
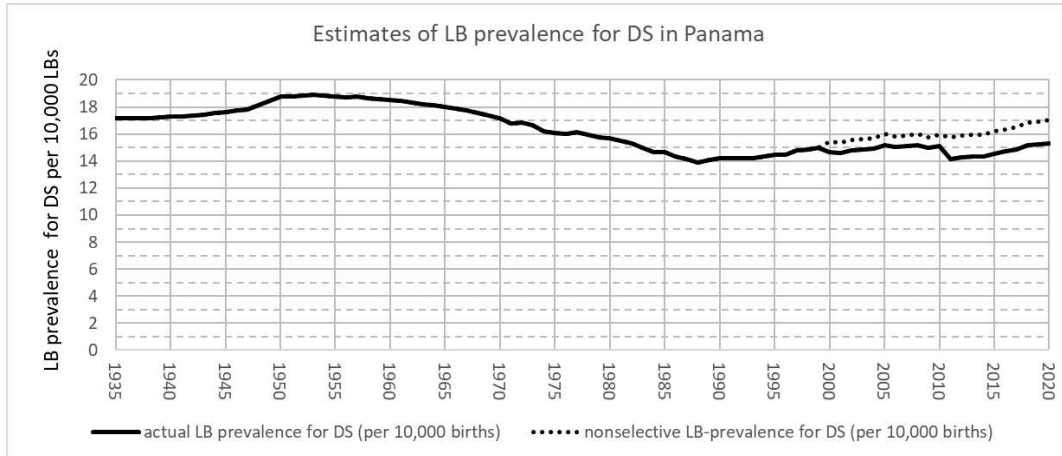


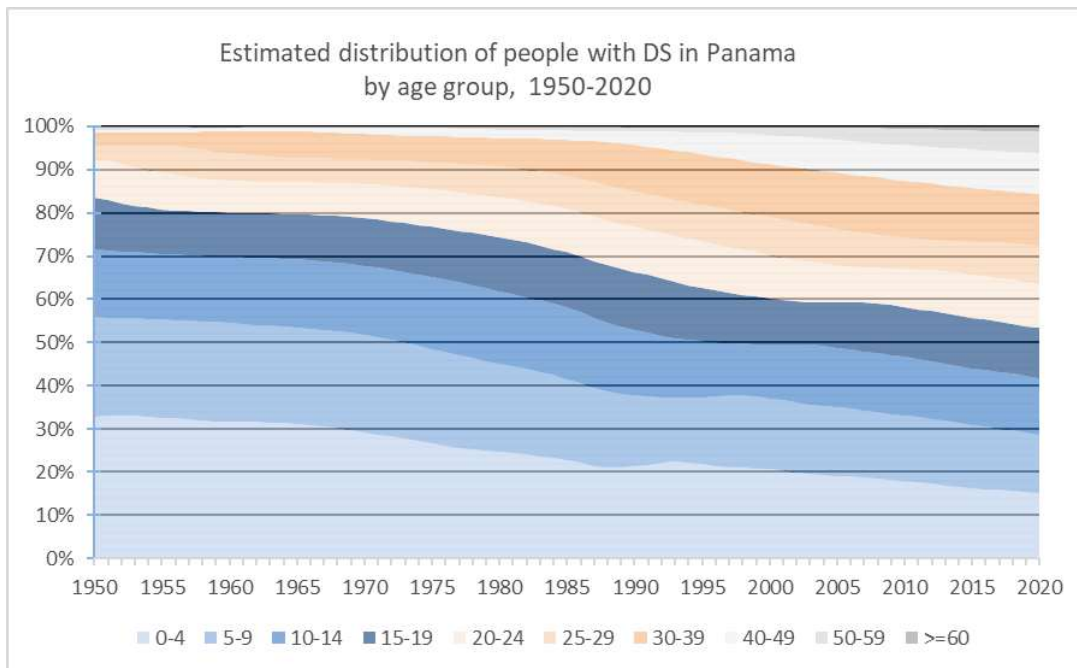
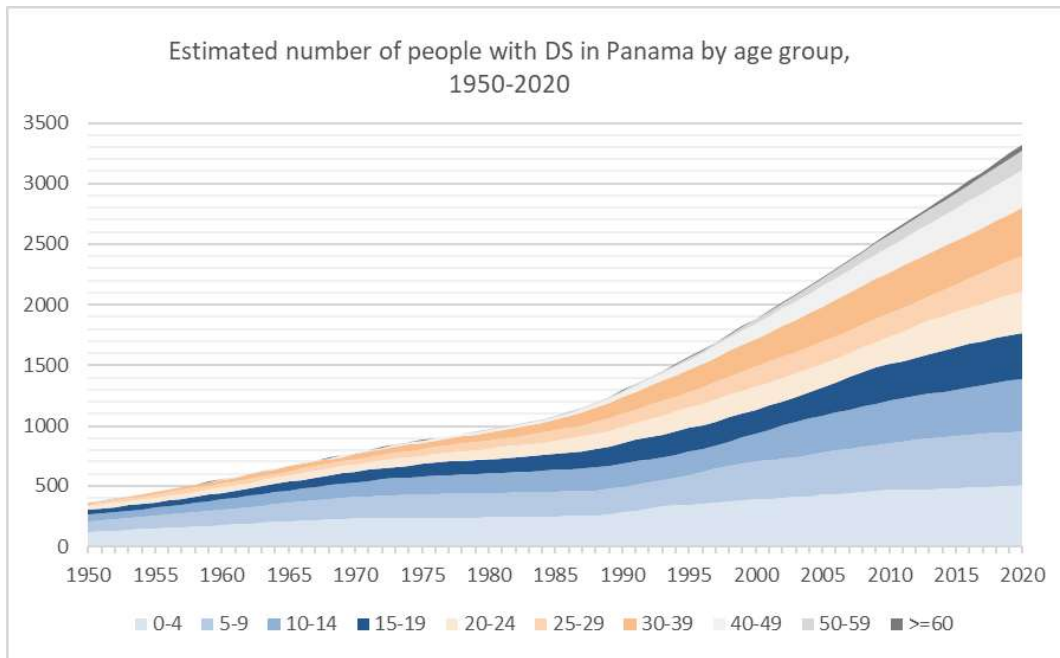


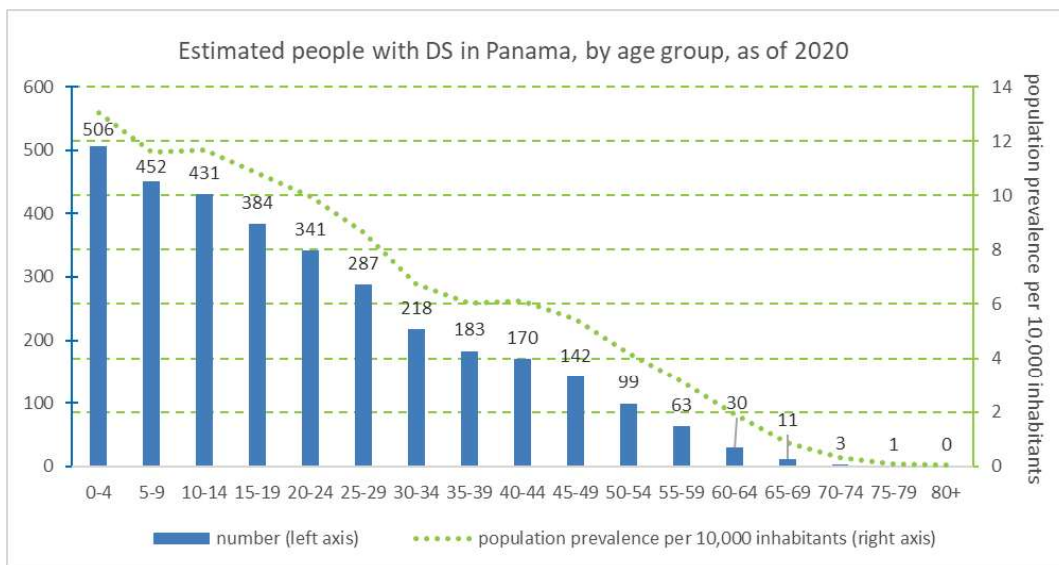
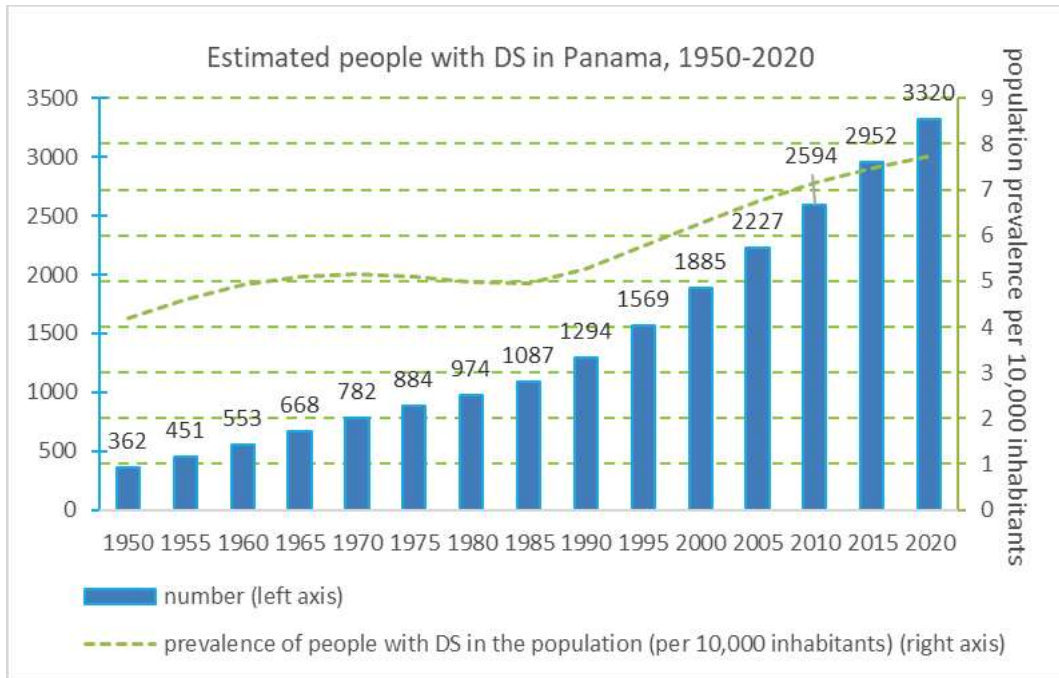


Panama

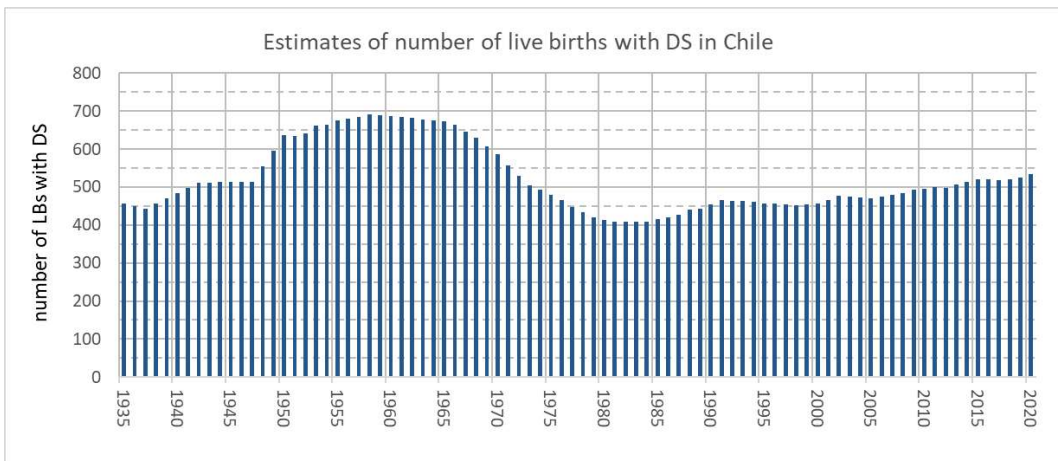
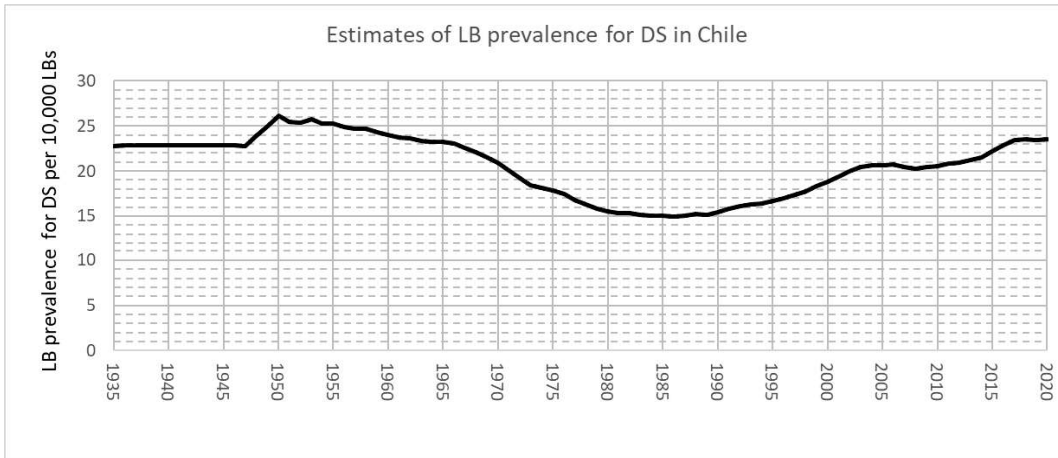


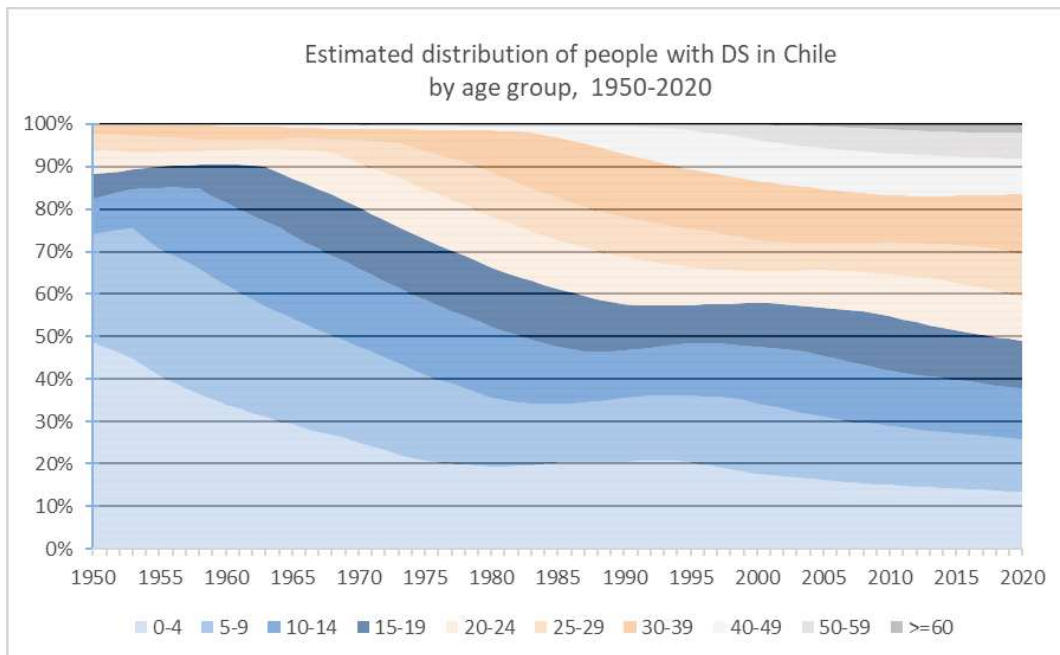
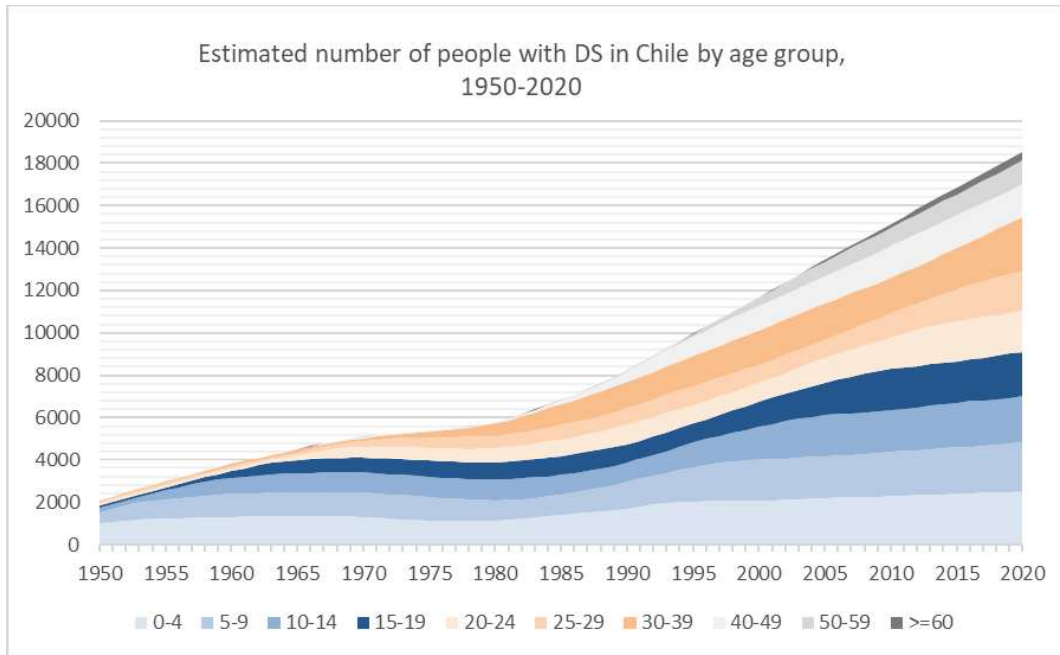


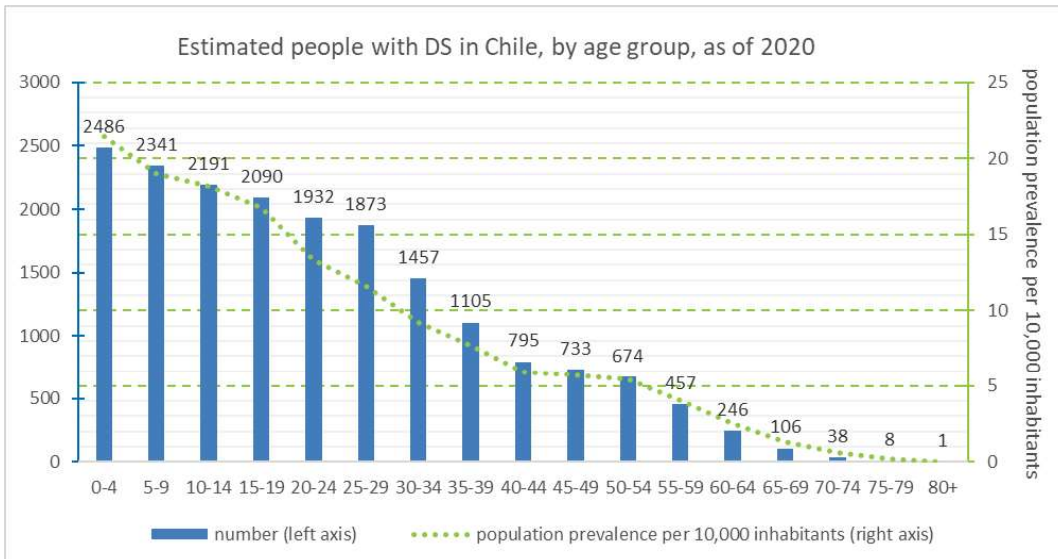
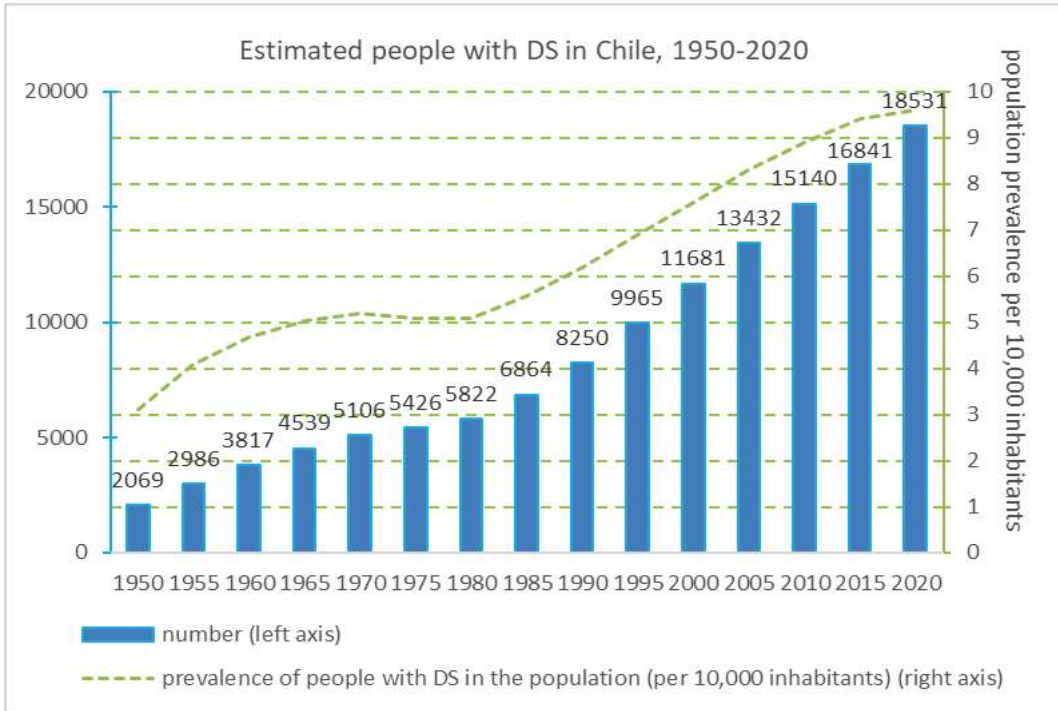


Chile
